For this year's 3daysofdesign, the design brands Form & Refine and Kurage, explore this idea through their shared exhibition, 'Form and Refine with Courage.' Here, you're invited to slow down and be present in the moment.

"'Form & Refine with Courage' reflects a belief that creating meaningful spaces takes a certain courage — to slow things down and shape what invites people to stay, pause and take it in. We invite our guests to explore that idea with us — a small breathing space within the rhythm of the city," Helle Herman Mortensen says, Co-founder of Form & Refine.

The Frederikstaden showroom will transform into a sanctuary, inviting visitors to slow down and simply be. It will be a place where guests can settle into an honest chair, savour an aromatic cup of coffee, and let their senses explore curtains and acoustic solutions crafted from lasting materials. "It's a space to lose yourself in conversation, connect with mindful arts and crafts, and find inspiration in every detail," Charlotte Fog Qvotrup adds, Brand Manager at Kurage. "Inspired by this year's theme, we've created our own version of the origami 'fortune teller' from the 3daysofdesign visuals. You can pick one up and try it. It includes prompts designed to calm your nervous system and open your mind to new observations."

Furniture, Drapery, and Acoustics

Visitors, or "guests" as the two brands like to call them, will be guided through rooms furnished with Form & Refine's iconic wooden pieces, complemented by Kurage's soft drapery and new acoustic wall concept.



New Designs Include

Form & Refine:

- With Andon Lamp, Form & Refine introduces its first lighting series — a lamp inspired by traditional Japanese lanterns and interpreted through a Nordic lens. Made from solid ash and fine paper, it provides a gentle, atmospheric light while bringing a calm, tactile presence to the space.
- Extension of the Taper Collection introduces stainless steel, adding a refined industrial edge to the series while maintaining its signature lightness and sculptural simplicity.
- A new deep brown finish is introduced across selected designs, including Beam Shelves and the Icon Lounge Chair, enhancing the natural character of the wood with a warm, calming tone. The same exploration of tones is carried into the new Monolith Side Table — a compact, multifunctional piece defined by solid wood, refined joinery and a strong, architectural expression.
