

Nordiska Kök opens Kitchen Atelier on historic Bredgade in Copenhagen

Like a fusion of a traditional showroom and an immersive brand experience – that’s how the Swedish kitchen brand Nordiska Kök describes its newly opened Kitchen Atelier on Bredgade in the heart of Copenhagen. The focus is on considered and innovative Scandinavian design and timeless craftsmanship, where architectural elements, carefully selected materials, and a clear spatial structure work in dialogue.

The Kitchen Atelier concept has been developed in close collaboration with interior design studio Nathalie Schwer, as part of the flagship store of the renowned Danish furniture company Brdr. Krüger. The overall interior reflects a shared approach to design, where Nordiska Kök and Brdr. Krüger meet at the intersection of design and architecture.

The Kitchen design

The showroom itself is conceived as a hybrid environment: part laboratory and part exhibition. It goes beyond display, offering a setting for exploration — where materials can be experienced, ideas tested, and craftsmanship understood at close range.

At its center, Nordiska Kök introduces an asymmetrical kitchen composition that balances a sense of familiarity with the precision of a working studio. The kitchen is approached as a contemporary reinterpretation — where known elements are carefully taken apart and recomposed, bringing a renewed energy into the space. Within the architectural context of Bredgade, the showroom shifts character from something expected into a more investigative environment.

A custom-built material shelving system anchors the space. Developed to present Nordiska Kök’s material palette — including wood, steel, glass, and terrazzo — it is designed with restraint, allowing the materials themselves to define the visual experience.
