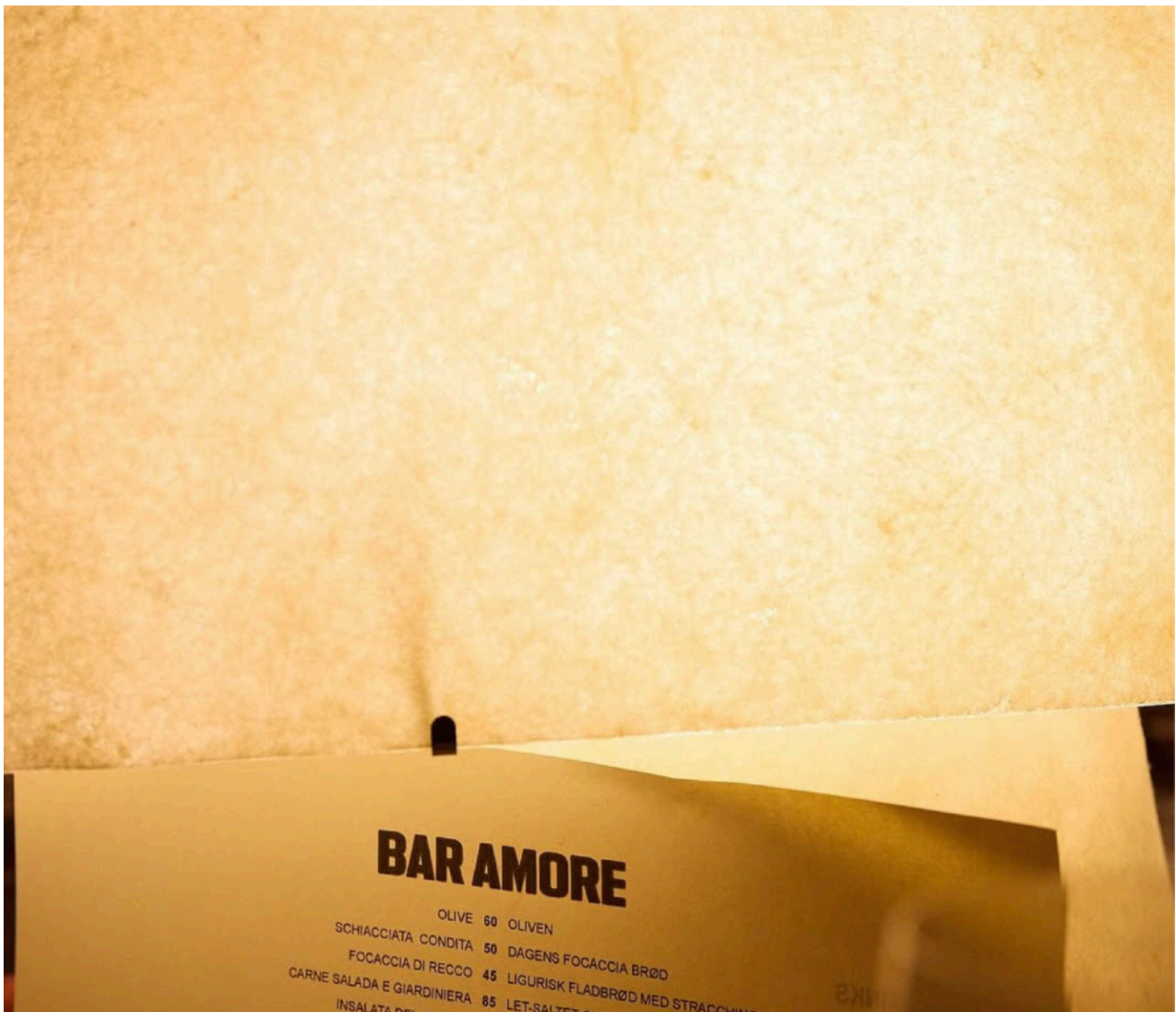
Kilzi at 3DaysofDesign

Kilzi x Bar Amore

During 3DaysofDesign, KILZI will be hosted by BAR AMORE in Frederiksberg, where his "Mush" Lamps have been part of the space since their opening in 2024.

The seemingly natural connection between the both of them finds its focus on their differences: BAR AMORE being contemporary, minimalistic and product oriented, KILZI being all about human connection, sensibility and the complex unique forms of craftsmanship. The middle point between the two philosophies will be rich in its contrast and surrounded by enjoyment and the buzz of this unique location.

Featured works will include a series of floral inspired patterns and the natural warmth of June. This is a reflection on the Mediterranean both Bar Amore and Kilzi breaths from but, also an ode to Summer and Midsummer Festivities.

Summer Nights

Summer Nights is a curated spatial installation presented during 3daysofdesign. Located opposite Kongens Have and Rosenborg Castle, the exhibition examines the atmosphere of a summer night in Copenhagen through material presence and spatial composition.

A double bed forms the central element of the installation. It is placed on thick, hand-knotted wool rugs and layered with alpaca duvets. Light, loosely hanging curtains define the space, functioning as both backdrop and soft enclosure. Hand-thrown ceramic objects and centrepiece vases are introduced as structural accents within the setting.

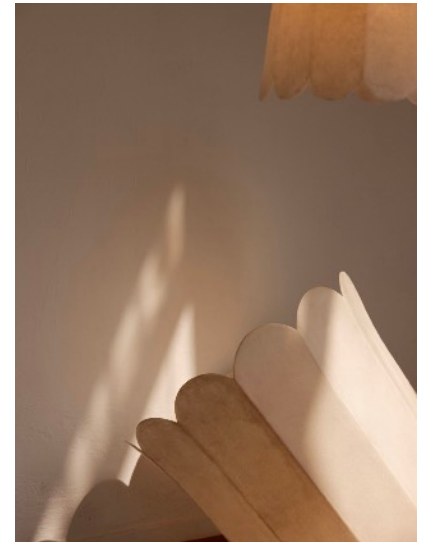
The exhibition is conceived as an interior in suspension — between rest and display, domesticity and abstraction. Materials, scale, and proximity establish a calm and measured environment, where objects are experienced through texture, weight, and spatial rhythm.
