*'THOUGHT / FUL' AT FRAMING FOR 3DAYSOFDESIGN 2026*

*New collections explore a more considered, thoughtful approach to hospitality-led design*

**Feature: Bruno Lounge Chair – new collection from LAYAN Studio**

Stellar Works, the Japanese-founded furniture brand with a global presence, presents an installation at 3daysofdesign 2026 that explores quiet luxury through hospitality-led design. Returning to the historic Odd Fellow Palace in central Copenhagen as part of the FRAMING exhibition, the installation builds on the brand's evolving creative direction, presenting new collections alongside refined iterations of existing designs.

Conceived in close collaboration with Space Copenhagen and artistic director Tony Chambers, THOUGHT / FUL comprises two adjoining environments – one calm and reduced, the other more layered and engaging – reflecting a shared sensibility for atmosphere, materiality and human scale.





## STELLAR WORKS

At the core of the presentation are Stellar Works' new 2026 collections, featuring pieces by LAYAN Studio, Yabu Pushelberg and Keiji Ashizawa Design (KAD) – a new addition to Stellar Works' roster of collaborators. Showcasing the brand's ongoing dialogue between craftsmanship, culture and hospitality design, these new collections are joined by new additions to Space Copenhagen's Atelier modular sofa system.

More than just a presentation of new collections, the space is conceived as a realistic spatial experience that invites visitors to engage all five senses – reflecting Stellar Works' dedication to creating environments that prioritise comfort, atmosphere and connection.

This year's THOUGHT / FUL theme builds on the brand's Omotenashi installation in 2025, which explored the Japanese philosophy of wholehearted hospitality. Here, that ethos is distilled into a quieter, more introspective expression. Nature and horticultural elements are integrated throughout the installation – reflecting the new visual communication codes of the brand.

Introduced with a purpose beyond mere decoration, the plants serve as a living presence, evolving throughout the show's lifespan and bringing a rhythm and a quiet sense of care to the space. Hospitality is conveyed through care rather than spectacle, and through intuitive design gestures rather than overt statements.

### **Room 01: THOUGHT**

A celebration of Stellar Works' long-standing creative partnership with Space Copenhagen, Room 1 showcases key pieces from the studio's portfolio for the brand, including new additions to the Atelier modular sofa system. These include integrated tray elements and accompanying lounge and side tables, crafted from a range of materials, including warm timber and tactile sandstone, which expand the system's flexibility while maintaining its sculptural clarity. Further products hand-selected for the room include mohair low-pile rugs and Freja black oak chairs by Space Copenhagen.

### **Room 02: FUL**

More complex and engaging, Room 2 is defined by its composition. Textures, tonal contrasts and objects are brought into closer dialogue, forming a richer and more absorbing environment. Anchored by a central bar, the space invites conversation while maintaining a clear overall composition.

Products in this room spotlight the new 2026 collections, including the Bruno and Arden pieces by LAYAN Studio, the Timothy pieces by Yabu Pushelberg and the Ougi collection

**Feature: Ougi Dining Chair – new collection from Keiji Ashizawa Design (KAD)**

by Keiji Ashizawa Design (KAD). A Stellar Works Bespoke Hi-Fi speaker console designed by KAD in collaboration with Dynaudio brings an added resonance to the space – an early preview of a potential future collection piece.

Signe Bindslev Henriksen & Peter Bundgaard Rützou of Space Copenhagen, comment: *'With this installation, we wanted to explore how furniture can shape atmosphere in a subtle yet meaningful and intuitive way. The installation is conceived as two complementary environments that invite visitors to slow down, reflect and experience the space through material, light and composition. Rather than placing emphasis on individual objects, the intention is to create a considered setting – one where design, hospitality and human experience converge naturally, offering a quiet source of inspiration.'*

On this year's 3dd showcase, Daisuke Hironaka, CEO of Stellar Works, states: *'Following last year's brand refocus, this presentation continues to refine our direction. Understated Luxury allows us to express hospitality in its most intuitive form – through material intelligence, craftsmanship and a deep sensitivity to how spaces are experienced. Each detail is considered to create environments that feel both effortless and enduring.'*



## STELLAR WORKS

Tony Chambers, Founder of TC & Friends and Artistic Director of Stellar Works, adds: *'Rather than presenting design as a collection of objects, THOUGHT / FUL proposes an environment shaped by how people move, interact and spend time within it – reflecting a broader shift in hospitality towards more considered, experience-driven spaces.'*



**Feature: Timothy Armchair & Dining Table – new collection from Yabu Pushelberg**

Stellar Works, known for introducing applications of recycled materials within furniture and interior environments, has once again partnered with YKK. Drawing on YKK's expertise in material innovation, the partnership explores how advanced components can be adapted across different contexts. Developed through shared research, these solutions are integrated as refined, functional details – supporting durability, sustainability and long-term performance in hospitality settings.

The 3daysofdesign installation also marks another step in Stellar Works' expansion across Europe. As the brand continues to develop its hospitality-led design philosophy internationally and prepares to open its Clerkenwell showroom in London in 2026, it will create a platform for dialogue with the European design community.
