Rooted in Swedish design heritage and an enduring commitment to craftsmanship, DUX continues to unite engineering precision with timeless Scandinavian aesthetics.

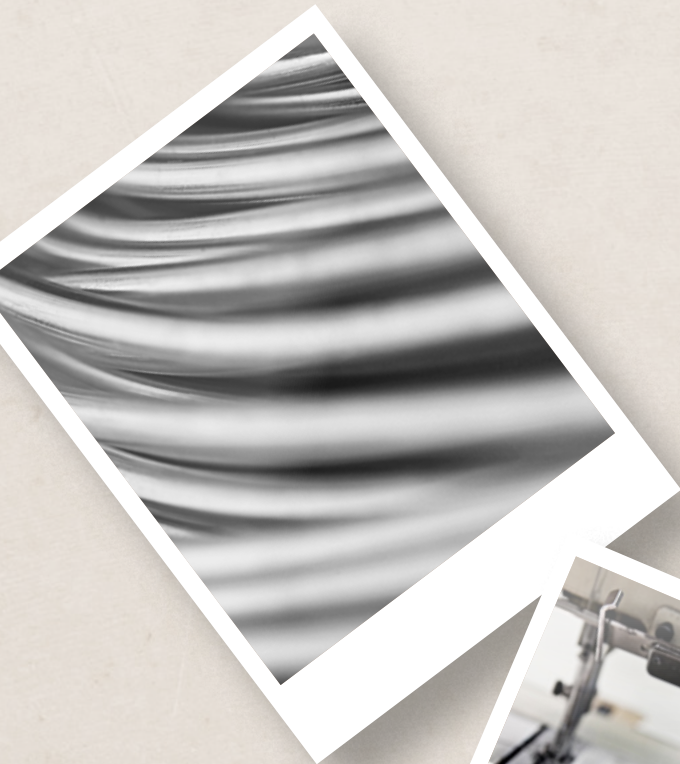

Crafted in Sweden using slow-grown pine, high-tensile steel, natural latex, cotton, and wool, every DUX product is designed with both performance and responsibility in mind. The brand's commitment to sustainability is embedded in its construction principles, allowing components to be replaced or upgraded over time, ensuring not only exceptional comfort, but a lifecycle measured in decades rather than years. This approach defines DUX's interpretation of modern luxury: one grounded in durability, material integrity, and human-centred design.

Our **Sustainable Comfort** collection extends our philosophy, combining natural materials, modular construction, and advanced ergonomic performance to create products designed for longevity, adaptability, and reduced environmental impact. Lova by DUX

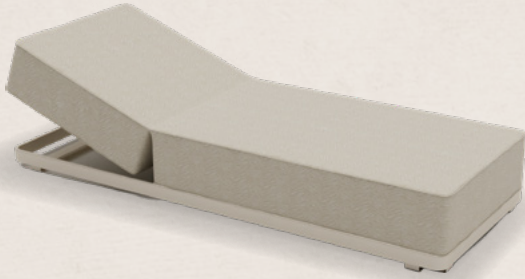

Known for his multidisciplinary approach spanning design, music and creative direction, Torpe brings a distinctly emotional and human-centred perspective to his work. His philosophy of creating meaningful connections between people and objects aligns closely with the DUX approach to comfort and considered design.

Combining expressive form with the signature comfort engineering of DUX, Lova has been designed to feel both sculptural and inviting, bringing together visual softness, balance and support in one distinctive piece.
