Andreu World presents its latest collections during 3daysofdesign inside the **By Malene Birger** showroom in central Copenhagen. The exhibition highlights the brand's commitment to **responsible design, material innovation**, and long-term sustainability.

A central feature is the **BIO® thermopolymer**, a next-generation material made from **natural, renewable, and biodegradable sources**. It offers high performance, durability, and full recyclability, reinforcing the brand's **circular-economy vision**. The exhibition also introduces a new **color palette** developed with **Patricia Urquiola**, inspired by **Mediterranean landscapes** and designed to complement natural materials and contemporary interiors.

The exhibition runs **June 10–12**, from **9:00 to 18:00**, at **Antonigade 10, 1106 Copenhagen**.

Andreu World has developed a BIO® thermopolymer that is a world first, a plastic that is not a plastic because it is not derived from fossil fuels. It is of natural origin, with a biological base produced by living microorganisms through the fermentation of genetically modified bacteria, to which natural fillers and plant-based additives generated in nature are added. It offers a sustainability profile similar to that of wood. It is recyclable, biodegradable, and compostable. It was introduced with the Nuez Lounge BIO® armchair, designed by Patricia Urquiola, and is also used in other collections. It has been technically improved to provide greater elasticity and robustness.
