Ryota Yokozeki's Tokyo-based studio moves fluidly between furniture, lighting, home accessories, and creative direction – always guided by the conviction that beauty is all around us, waiting to be found. Born in Gifu, Japan, he trained at the Kanazawa College of Art before spending a decade as an industrial designer at Sony's Creative Center in Tokyo, where precision became the quiet foundation of his craft.

He established Ryota Yokozeki Studio Inc. in 2017 – a practice shaped by experimental play, deep contemplation, and an enduring respect for the dialogue between designer and maker.

Sekiun takes inspiration from cumulus clouds that constantly shift across the sky, changing their beauty with time, location, and season.

Made by rolling and layering two pieces of specially coated white washi paper, creating an airy, soft, layered shape like cumulus clouds. The clean, bright diffusion gives an even, refined light quality that shifts with the angle from which you view the lamp, constantly bringing a fresh feeling to the space.
