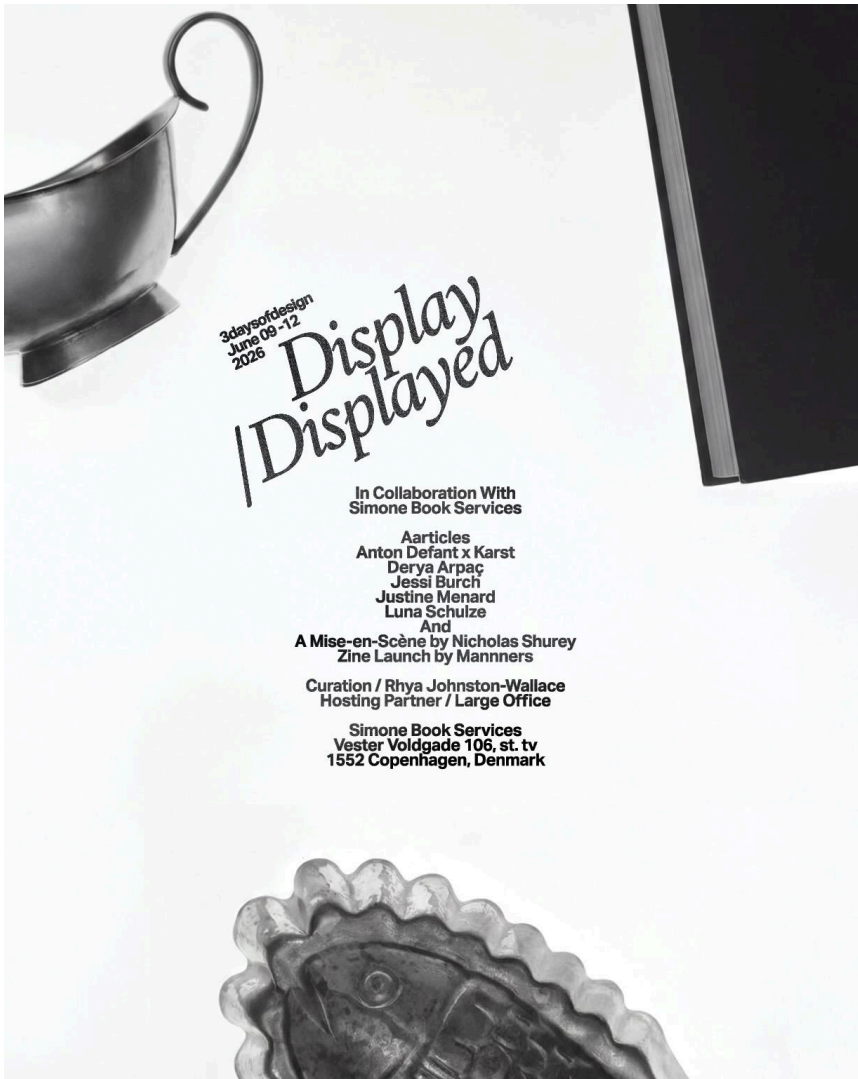

Introducing Display / Displayed, an exhibition for 3daysofdesign in collaboration with Simone Book Services that looks at objects of and for display across books, design, and photography in Copenhagen from June 9-12.

Objects on display are often mistaken for objects of frivolity. In truth, the desire to display an object in one's home does not negate its function. Rather, it stands to reason that its function works in tandem with its decorative appeal. And aren't we, after all, much more likely to impart use and meaning on an object that lives out in the open?

Exhibition Participants

Produced by a team of close friends for the love of their chosen practices, Display / Displayed is, above all else, an exercise in creative collaboration. Bringing together the works of international artists and local collaborators, the exhibition will feature book stands curated by Aarticles (Copenhagen), two site-specific works designed for the exhibition by Anton Defant and Karst (Berlin), new shelving and ceramics by Derya Arpaç (Copenhagen), home objects by Jessi Burch (New York), new hand-blown glass objects and site-specific additions by Justine Menard (Barcelona), and conceptual handmade cutlery by Luna Schulze (Copenhagen).

Nicholas Shurey will unveil a new piece of functional sculpture in his signature organic motif, accompanied by a mise-en-scène designed for the occasion.

Manners, a still-life photography studio founded by photographer Ed Gumuchian and art director Michelle Walters, has produced a zine for the exhibition that features the sentimental objects of several design opinion leaders.

Simone Book Services will curate and display an archival selection of books centered around the exhibition's theme.

The exhibition is curated by **Rhya Johnston-Wallace**, a FRAMA alumnus now working on creative projects across communications, cultural programs, and storytelling with her namesake consultancy, RJW Consulting.

Jeppe Dalsgaard of Large Office, a digital marketing agency working with consumer brands such as Service Projects, Assembly, Artek, and Veark, is co-hosting and supporting production.

The exhibition takes place at Simone Book Services, a new specialized bookstore and curatorial practice in Copenhagen that holds rare, out-of-print, and independent editions. Simone's practice extends to library curation for brand spaces, and archive material for storytelling and exhibitions—culturally grounded and digitally fatigue-free. The space itself was designed by architect and furniture designer Derya Arpaç and features commissioned pieces by Kasper Kyster, Daniel Schofield, Lærke Ryom, and Steffan Sundström.
