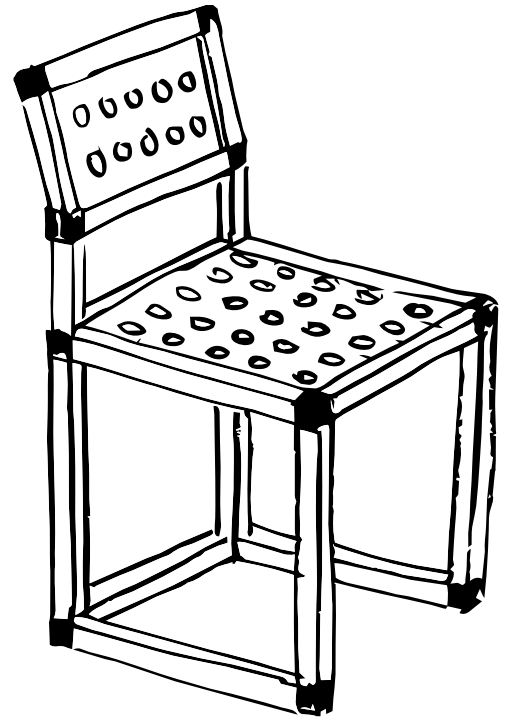

## HEAD OUTSIDE – INTRODUCING THE XD OUTDOOR SERIES

This June, The Form Follows makes its debut at 3daysofdesign in Copenhagen and marks its first anniversary as an independent design brand. Founded in Vienna, The Form Follows creates contemporary furniture and everyday objects that combine function, personality and a playful approach to design. Across furniture, lighting and accessories, the brand explores forms that are expressive yet approachable, creating pieces that become part of daily life rather than simply occupying space. One year after its launch, The Form Follows arrives at 3daysofdesign to present its evolving collection and celebrate its first milestone.

It's June. The city is buzzing. Nobody wants to stay inside – neither does the XD series. Expanding beyond the interior, the XD Outdoor Series, designed by Klemens Schillinger, introduces a new chapter for the collection with an outdoor chair, stool and lounge tables. Maintaining the distinctive geometry and relaxed character of the original series, XD moves into open-air settings and creates new opportunities to gather, pause and spend time outdoors. Alongside the existing finishes, the collection welcomes a new vibrant color created especially for the outdoor launch. Familiar yet refreshed, the series continues to explore objects that encourage interaction and fit naturally into everyday rituals.

To celebrate both the launch and the first year of The Form Follows, visitors are invited to discover the collection at Café Niko on Paper Island's waterfront during 3daysofdesign. Stop by for an exclusive first look, stay for a coffee and experience the atmosphere around the new outdoor setting. Between 4–6 PM, everyone purchasing a coffee at Café Niko will have the opportunity to join a giveaway featuring selected pieces from The Form Follows collection. Whether dropping in for a short break, slowing down for the afternoon or starting the evening by the water – this June is an invitation to head outside.
