So let's make it a send-off to remember!

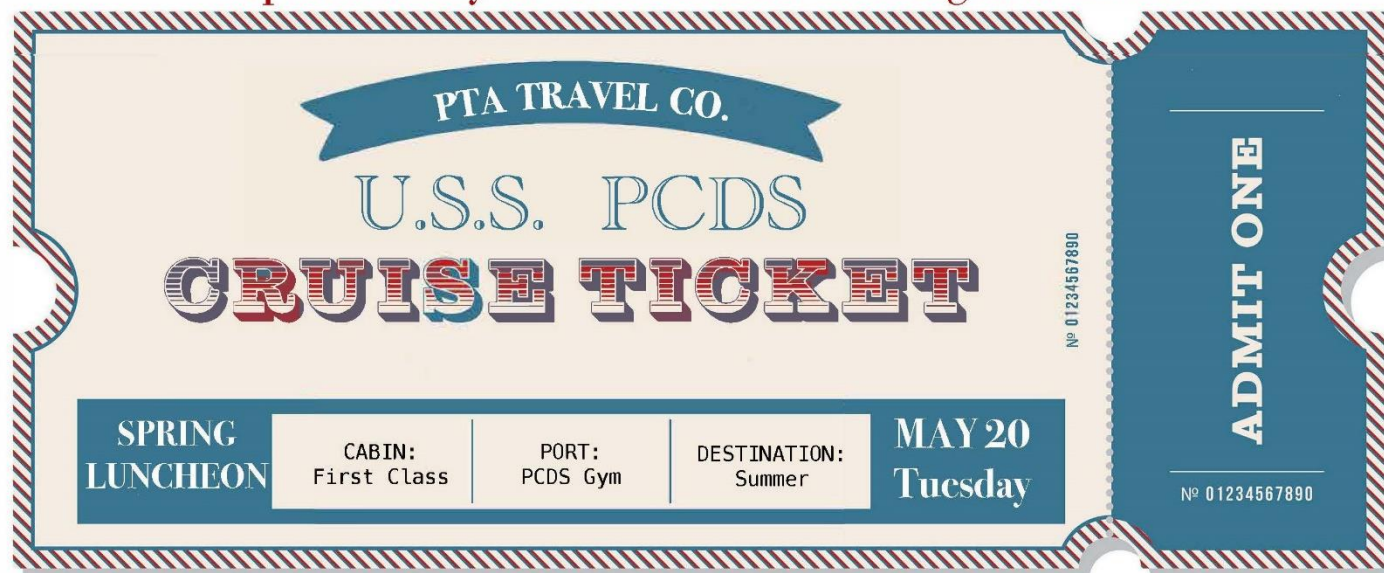

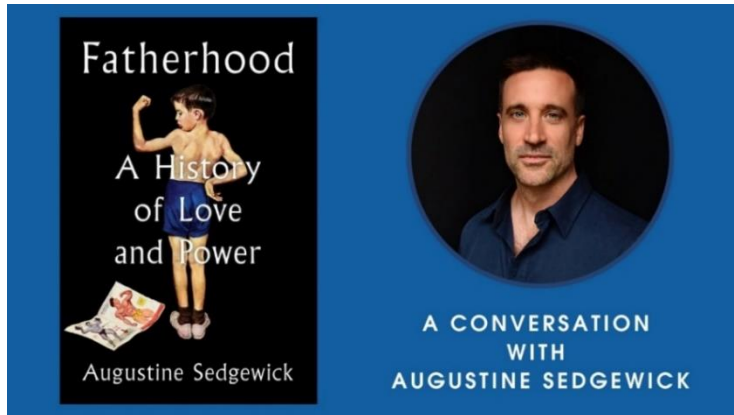
