Get ready to build, design, and imagine! In our architecture program, children will explore the exciting world of buildings and structures- learning what makes a house strong, what different buildings are used for, and how architects bring ideas to life. Using fun, hands-on materials like popsicle sticks, paper goods, and recycled items, children will design and construct their own creative structures while experimenting with balance, shape, and stability.



Inspired by stories like *Iggly Peck, Architect* and *Young Frank, Architect*, they'll discover how anything—from toys to everyday objects—can become part of a design. As the program continues, children will build houses for stuffed animals and create structures using toothpicks, marshmallows, sugar cubes, and spaghetti.
