

Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive



- Thresholds meet 2 out of these 3 criteria
 - > € 50 million net turnover
 - > € 25 million in assets
 - > 250 employees
- Standardized reporting on ESG
- The Omnibus package:
 Accepted "Stop the clock" proposal: delay of 2
 years for reporting obligations
 Under discussion: simplyfing reporting

Ecodesign for Sustainable Products Regulation








- Enforced in 2024
- Get products designed for circular economy Replaceable batteries for repair and recycling
- **-**
- Digital Product Passport (first due in 2027 for textiles, consumer electronics and automotive)
 - incl impact reports per product

GCD

Green Claims Directive



- Into force in 2026 (tier 1 in March 2024)
- Prevent greenwashing
- When claims are made, they need to be support with third party verified documents
- Specific wording prohibited (eco, green, environmentally friendly etc)
- Impact calculation based on at least 6 factors, counting for at least 80% of the impact
