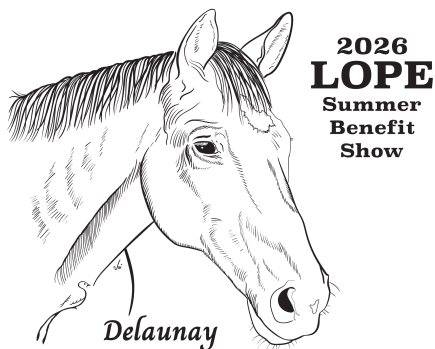

~Hunter & Equitation Over Fences~

To be shown in properly fitting safe tack of discipline. Over Fences classes must be in English tack. Helmets are required in jumping classes. Abuse, hitting, aggressiveness, and poor horsemanship will not be tolerated. Correct posting diagonals and leads will be judged.

Jumps can be anything you like, fill or no fill, wing standards or simple. Don't have jump standards? Use barrels to set up your jumps. Don't have fill? Don't worry, set simple jumps. Poles can be set without any jump standards, just two poles on the ground!

Horses can be shared by riders. In Equitation classes any one horse can be ridden by many riders. In Hunter classes each horse can only be ridden by 2 riders in any one division (ex: "Bob" can be ridden by two riders in Poles, but not more than two, but he can also be ridden by two riders in 2' and other divisions)

Divisions: Poles ~ Crossrails ~ 2Ft ~ 2'3"-2'6" ~ 2'9" & Above (Hunter & Equitation)

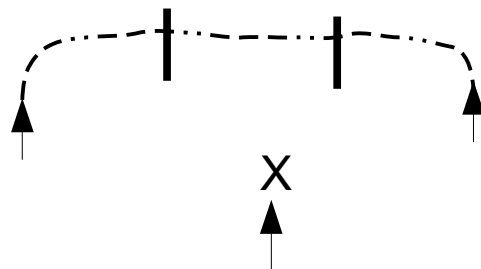
Management and judge have the right to divide/combine the divisions by height based on the amount of entries received.

Hunter & Equitation Over Fences:

- Ride 2 lines of 2 jumps at your chosen height. This can be the same line of jumps just ridden in both directions. Do not jump oxers backwards.
- Ride one line off a left approach and one line off of a right approach. Pause your video between the two lines and have both lines on one video.
- Show around 5 canter strides or 15 trot strides before your first jump and after the second one.
- Show corners before and after the lines.
- Jumps can be anywhere from 4-8 strides apart. (you must announce at the beginning of your video what the stride length or distance in feet is between your jumps)
- Trot in trot out, trot in canter out, or canter in canter out will all be accepted.

***One video can be entered to judge BOTH the Hunter Under Saddle and the Equitation On the Flat classes. Separate videos are also fine.**

Riders will receive feedback from our judge.



VIDEOGRAPHER POSITION

Stay in one place about half way between both jumps and follow the rider. Try to keep the horse and rider around $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ of the screen. Announce the rider, horse, class, jump height, and line distance at the start of the video.
