### Accessing Boulder Care

Schedule a virtual appointment as early as the next day!

Call a Boulder enrollment specialist at (866) 969–3635 and have ready:

• Patient's Name, DOB, insurance, phone/email and facility point of contact

## Virtual clinic appointment

At your scheduled time, go to visit.boulder.care

- Boulder will call you at the phone number you provided during enrollment to provide you with an access code
- The first appointment may take up to 1 hour

# Filling a prescription

Boulder will send the prescription following the appointment

- Prescriptions can be filled at an in-house pharmacy or picked up by a staff member at an outside local pharmacy
- Prescriptions cannot be picked up by a patient's friend or family member
- For refills, call Boulder at (866) 969–3635 to schedule a follow-up appointment

### Continuing care after release

Boulder will provide instructions for ongoing care, which includes how to download the app on a personal device and how to access their account. We prescribe FDA approved medicines, including Suboxone. Medication for Addition Treatment (MAT) is the gold standard of care. MAT is very effective at reducing symptoms, like cravings and withdrawal, and is linked to long-term success and well-being. An evidence-based MAT path to recovery can help you achieve a happier, healthier life —and stay in recovery.
