## University of Exeter Students' Guild Prize Draw Terms and Conditions 2026

By entering this prize draw, you agree to these Terms and Conditions.

This prize draw is run by the **University of Exeter Students' Guild** ("the Students' Guild").

### 1. Eligibility

1. The prize draw is only open to individuals who:
  - Are **registered students at the University of Exeter**, and
  - Are **eligible to vote** in the **Leadership Elections 2026**, and
  - Submit a valid vote during the election period (**9–12 February 2026**).
2. Staff of the Students' Guild and anyone professionally connected with the draw may not enter.
3. **One entry per person** is permitted, regardless of how many positions you vote for.
4. Entry is **free** and no purchase is necessary.

### 2. How to Enter

1. To enter, you must submit a vote in the **Leadership Elections 2026** between:  
**10:00 on 9 February 2026 and 16:00 on 12 February 2026.**
2. All eligible voters who cast a vote during this period will automatically be entered into the prize draw.
3. The Students' Guild is not responsible for entries that cannot be processed due to incomplete or inaccurate contact details.

### 3. The Prizes

1. There are up to **five (5) prizes** available, depending on voter participation levels.
2. Prizes are "unlocked" only if the required voter thresholds are reached.
3. If the required voter numbers are not met, the Students' Guild reserves the right **not to award** those prizes.
4. Prize thresholds are:

5. The Students' Guild's use of brand names does not imply endorsement or affiliation.
6. Prizes are:
  - Non-transferable
  - Non-exchangeable
  - No cash alternative will be offered
7. The Students' Guild reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if necessary, due to circumstances beyond its control.

#### **4. Winner Selection**

1. Winners will be selected at random from all eligible entries.
2. The draw will be carried out using a verifiable random selection process, and the Students' Guild will retain records of the draw outcome.
3. The Students' Guild's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

#### **5. Winner Notification**

1. Winners will be notified via their University of Exeter email address no later than:

**Tuesday 17 February 2026.**

2. If a winner cannot be contacted or does not respond within **7 days**, the Students' Guild reserves the right to select an alternative winner.

#### **6. Prize Collection**

1. Prizes must be collected in person from either:
  - Guild Reception (Devonshire House, Streatham Campus), or

- G48 Reception (South Cloisters, St Luke's Campus)
- 2. Winners must present:
  - The prize confirmation email, and
  - Valid University Unicaard identification

## **7. Data Protection and Publicity**

1. Personal information will only be used for administering the prize draw, in accordance with the Students' Guild Privacy Notice.
2. The Students' Guild may publish winners' first names on its social media channels (@exeterguild).
3. Winners may be asked for a photo with their prize, but this will only be shared with the winner's explicit written consent.

## **8. Limitation of Liability**

1. The Students' Guild accepts no responsibility for any issues arising from use of the prize once collected.
2. Any warranty or product-related issues are the responsibility of the prize winner and the prize manufacturer/provider.

## **9. General**

1. The Students' Guild reserves the right to cancel, amend, or withdraw the prize draw where necessary, including where required for legal or operational reasons.
2. Any changes will be communicated as soon as reasonably possible.
