# ANGELS IN OUR MIDST

Thirty years ago Sid Rosenblatt was one of the founders of what we currently call FALA. He was a part of the Adult Care Association of Florida which merged with Suncoast Adult Care Association, and Florida Residential Care Association to create one larger voice for what was then Adult Care Living Facilities. From 1992 until his retirement, Sid was an advocate and leader for others. In 2004, the association created an award of Excellence in Leadership named after him which continues to be presented each year to a person selected from the assisted living profession who has shown outstanding leadership within the organization and in their own community. 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
