How it's implemented

Bend-La Pine Schools use Wayfinder in K-12 classrooms districtwide. To ensure a successful rollout, they began implementation with maximum flexibility for the schools that needed it. While middle school advisories offered a solid anchor for a tailored scope + sequence from year one, elementary and high schools expanded to full implementation by years two and three, respectively.

Offering Multiple Access Points Across Grade Bands

Elementary schools use the Activity Library + Waypoints, with the ability to opt in to the Core Curriculum.

Middle schools fully implement Wayfinder Core in Advisory + Health.

High schools have opt-in access to the Activity Library + Waypoints.

Expanding Elementary + High School Usage; Refining in Middle

Elementary schools fully implement all K-5 Wayfinder offerings.

Middle schools tailor use by site; fully implement in Advisory only.

High schools use the Activity Library + Waypoints, with opt-in access to the Core Curriculum.

Elementary schools continue full implementation.

Middle schools further tailor use by site; fully implement in Advisory.

High schools fully implement, using the Activity Library, Waypoints, and Core Curriculum Fast Track option (at minimum).
