For those whose garage is too crowded with his-and-her Rivians, the 1962 Ferrari can soon have its own temperature-controlled home. The Hangar Group, a luxury storage facility with two locations in Florida, already has a wait list for its forthcoming outpost near the Gabreski Airport. In addition to luxury cars, wine and art collections are welcome in the 62 fully customizable “storage condos.” If permitting is approved, the Hangar will break ground in the fall. And if pricing is anything like in Palm Beach, where space costs up to \$1,000 per square foot for a unit, buyers could be paying as much as \$1.2 million for a spot.
