Ages 7-11 who are seeking baptism or seeking to join the Catholic Church meet after 10am mass on the last Sunday of every month beginning 26th April.

Ages 12-15 who wish to be baptised or to enter the Catholic Church should attend the Junior Alpha Course which begins on the 1st June, and if they wish to continue, the Communion and Confirmation preparation classes which will follow.

Ages 16 or older who are seeking Baptism or wish to become a member of the Catholic Church should attend Adult Alpha and then the Growing in Love and knowledge of Christ course which will begin in September on Tuesday evenings.
