Understanding How Your Rent is Calculated

- For tenants occupying social housing, rents will be charged at 25% of income, plus Commonwealth Rent Assistance payment.
- For tenants occupying affordable rental, generally higher income households, rents may be charged at 30% of income, plus any applicable Commonwealth Rent Assistance payment.
- Alliance Housing caps the Market Rent charged on individual properties at a maximum of 74.9% of the assessed Market
 Rent
