Documents relying upon the approved PHA Plan (i.e., Administrative Plan, Admission and Continued Occupancy Plan, etc.) should be updated to reflect those policies. Also, the approved PHA Plan and all required attachments and documents should be available for review and inspection at the PHA's principal office during normal business hours. Once posted, your plan will remain on display until your next Plan (Whether next year's plan or an intervening significant amendment or modification) is submitted and is approved by HUD.

Please note a housing authority has the option to amend or modify any PHA policy, rule, regulation, or other aspect of the 5-Year Plan or Annual Plan after submission to HUD subject to the requirements of 24 CFR 903.21.
