#### 2. Why I seek to serve in this office:

The Disciplinary Board is important to me because of the way it supports the integrity of our Church and people's trust in it. I have had experience with similar work with faculty members at my academic institution when they were involved in disciplinary matters. Therefore I feel prepared to handle the essentials of this responsibility, including confidentiality, transparency (within the bounds of confidentiality), fairness, and attention to the canons and the process they require. Further, being retired I am less subject to inappropriate influence while also having long-term experience within the Diocese. I will strive to bring the highest ethical standards to the task, should it be required.

## 3. Issues I believe are important in the life of the diocese and the church:

In terms of issues relevant to the Disciplinary Board, I think that trust in institutions is unfortunately low in the broader society. Our Diocese's attention to concerns such as Safe Church helps to counter that sinking trust, but our efforts need to be backed up with firm discipline, should there be infractions that rise to that level. We have been through, and continue to face, times of great stress and change for our clergy and congregations, and stress is more likely to lead to misconduct. Also, historical misconduct undermined public trust, which we must continue to work to strengthen.
