

Liturgy Commission Report for Convention 2025

The Liturgical Commission met throughout early 2025 and sketched out our goals for the year. When the Bishop Search Committee was appointed and both of our co-chairs were on it, it was decided that we needed to step back from the more active plans we had for the year and focus on a few tasks.

Members of our commission worked together with the Bishop's office to offer training and support for leading Morning Prayer. We put together four different mailings, one per season, to highlight and share different liturgical resources with the diocese. Such as resources for liturgical responses to gun violence, Morning Prayer resources, and Creation Care.

As we prepare for the transition to our next Bishop, the Commission is prepared to respond and reform in response to the leadership and needs set forth. Meanwhile, we will continue to be attentive to how we can support the liturgical vibrancy of our diocese and see where the Holy Spirit is guiding next.
