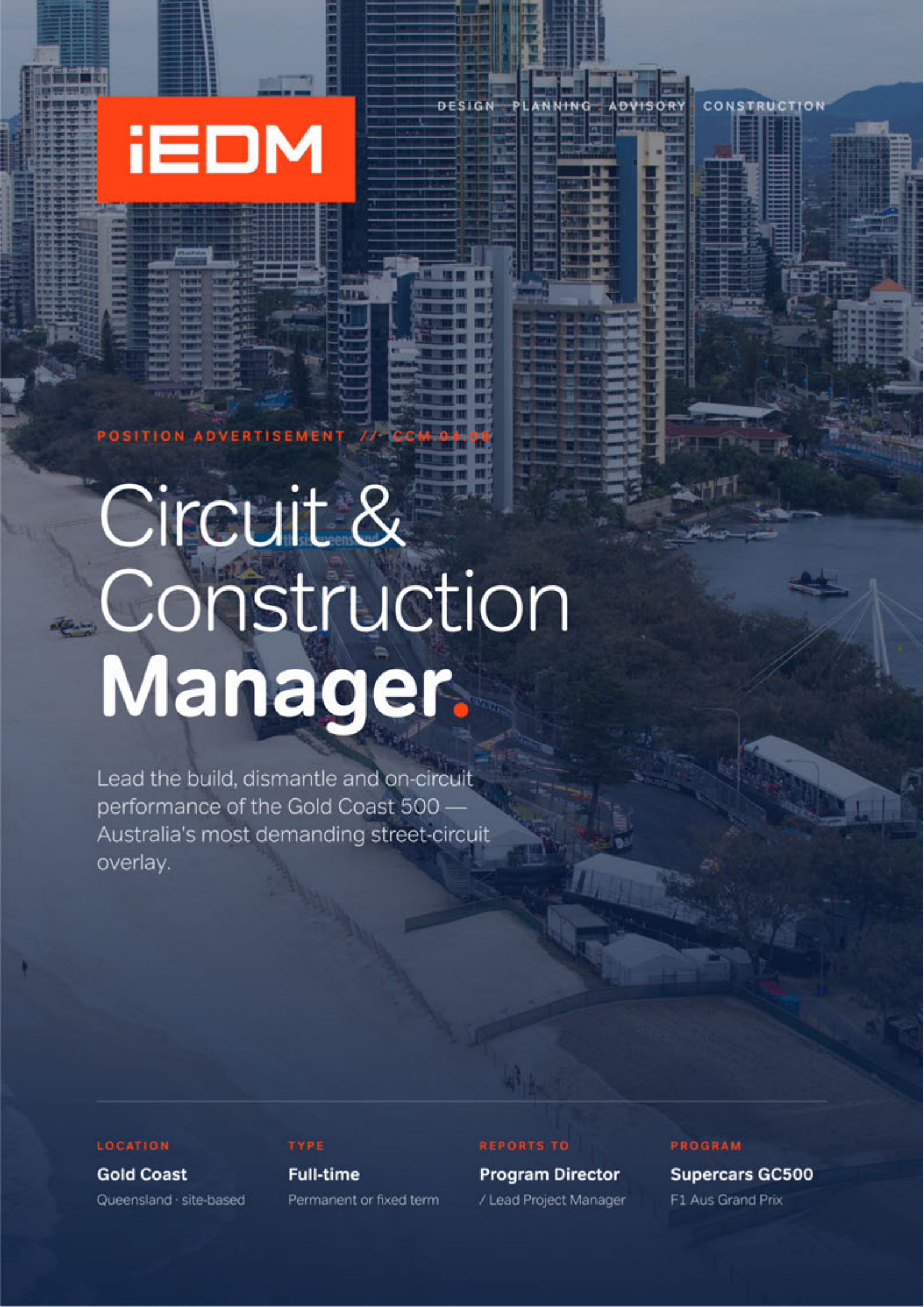

Circuit and Construction Manager

We're looking for a Circuit and Construction Manager to lead the safe, on-programme delivery of the Gold Coast 500 street circuit and infrastructure overlay.

This is a hands-on, site-based leadership role — present on site through every critical phase, owning the build, the dismantle, and the racing surface itself.

You'll lead a multi-disciplinary construction team, liaise directly with Motorsport Australia and the City of Gold Coast, and protect the standard our client and the public expect when the world is watching. Outside the GC500 build and dismantle peaks, you'll contribute to other iEDM event programs — including the **Formula 1 Australian Grand Prix**, the new **Perth Supercars event**, and other major events — with periods of interstate site-based work as the program requires.

WHAT YOU'LL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR

01 Circuit Management

- Own all track infrastructure — barriers, fencing, kerbing, surfacing, line marking
- Liaise directly with Motorsport Australia for inspections and track approval
- Lead remediation works to MSA satisfaction and oversee precinct handover

03 WHS & Safety Leadership

- Own the WHS Management Plan and supporting safety frameworks
- Ensure contractor compliance and ongoing site audits
- Liaise with WorkSafe and union representatives as required

05 Reporting & Team Leadership

- Lead Safety Manager, Senior Site Manager, Site Managers and Coordinators
- Run weekly works planning meetings with division leaders

02 Construction Programme

- Lead the GC500 build and dismantle programmes end-to-end
- Maintain site responsibility through Construction and Deconstruction phases
- Sequence contractors, manage exclusions, and resolve site issues live

04 Traffic & Stakeholder

- Lead vehicle and pedestrian traffic management across build and event phases
- Maintain relationships with City of Gold Coast and statutory authorities
- Manage interface with residents, development sites, and park tenants
