




## TC ILSA HOMEOWNERS RECOVERY & RESILIENCE GRANT

# **Dwelling Eligibility**

Submit an application online or by contacting The Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES).

You will need to provide proof of:

- Identity
- Ownership
- Occupancy

DFES will assess the eligibility of your dwelling and let you know the outcome.

Send quotes to DFES

DFES reviews and advises works eligibility

#### **Works Eligibility**

You decide on the works you want to do.

**Recovery** – Repair or rebuild the damaged dwelling to its pre-disaster state.

**Resilience** – Make improvements to the dwelling to make it more cyclone resistant.

Send quotes for the works to DFES for review.

\*Insured dwellings must use available insurance prior to reimbursement.

Complete Works

Send DFES completion photos and instructions for payment

Payment
of up to a
combined total
of \$50,000

#### **Works Completion**

When the works are finished, DFES will need the following evidence from you in order to assess eligibility:

- Pre-disaster photos
- Progress photos
- Geo-stamped completion photos
- Invoice or proof of payment
- Completion documents (DFES to supply)

DFES will let you know the outcome.

Works completed no later than 30 June 2026.

### **Funds Dispursed**

Payment of funds will be made when works are finished.

DFES will contact you to confirm the payment process and details.
