Eligibility: To be eligible a cadet must be aged between 11 and up to 18 years of age and currently registered as a cadet in a BGU or YES program.

Increasing the capacity of cadets or juniors by providing access to development opportunities

Establishing sustainable partnerships with local emergency services to promote and encourage the transition of young people from cadets to adult volunteering.
