EMERGENCY SITUATION DECLARATION BY HAZARD MANAGEMENT AGENCY

The FES Commissioner is the prescribed Hazard Management Agency (HMA) for emergency management for the hazard of Cyclone.

I, Craig Waters, Deputy Commissioner Operations of the Department of Fire and Emergency Services, as a delegate acting for the HMA hereby declare an emergency situation in respect of the Tropical Cyclone Luana (incident 769057).

The area of the State to which the emergency situation declaration applies is:

Shire of Broome, Shire of Derby/West Kimberley, and the Shire of Wyndham/East Kimberley.

Time when the declaration made: 20:40hrs

Date on which declaration made: 23 January 2026

This emergency situation declaration has effect from 0300hrs on 24 January 2026 and remains in force until:

- (a) expiry (3 days after taking effect); or
- (b) it is revoked under section 53 of the *Emergency Management Act 2005*; or
- (c) the expiry of any extension of the emergency situation declaration made by the State Emergency Coordinator under section 52 of the *Emergency Management Act 2005*.

This emergency situation declaration is made under section 50 of the *Emergency Management Act 2005*.
