EMERGENCY SITUATION DECLARATION BY HAZARD MANAGEMENT AGENCY

The FES Commissioner is the prescribed Hazard Management Agency (HMA) for emergency management for the hazard of Cyclone.

I, Craig Waters, Deputy Commissioner Operations of the Department of Fire and Emergency Services, as a delegate acting for the HMA do hereby declare an emergency situation in respect of the Severe Tropical Cyclone Narelle (incident 775618).
