### Background

It is designed for farmers, pastoralists, farm hands, rural landowners and managers.

The course covers topics such as tree hazard recognition, risk assessment, and safe work practices around hazardous trees during bushfire response or mitigation.



If you experience any issues viewing the course on your tablet or mobile device, we suggest downloading Google Chrome from the App Store and select it as your preferred browser.




