

# SEVERE TROPICAL CYCLONE NARELLE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PACKAGES

## Premier's Relief Payment

One-off payments to help eligible residents cover immediate living costs.

- \$4,000 for severely damaged or destroyed homes
- \$2,000 for homes with major damage

Applications close  
30 June 2026



## Premier's Natural Disaster Recovery Fund

One-off payments to support eligible residents, local businesses and community organisations.

- \$20,000 for severely damaged or destroyed homes
- \$10,000 for homes with major damage
- \$5,000 for local businesses and community groups

Applications close  
31 July 2026



## Australian Government Disaster Recovery Payment

A one-off, non-means tested payment for eligible adults and children.

- \$1,000 per adult
- \$400 per child under 16

7 October 2026



## Disaster Recovery Assistance Program for Primary Producers

Grants to support eligible primary producers with cyclone-related clean-up and reinstatement activities.

- Up to \$40,000

## Business Recovery Support Program

Grants to help eligible businesses with clean-up, repairs and reinstatement, with additional support available for Exmouth businesses that support tourism. Financial advice and counselling services are also available.

- Up to \$20,000

## Assistance for Primary Producers\*

Subsidies for eligible primary producers to assist with recovery and business continuity costs including for freight, fodder, fencing and loan interest support.

Short-term financial support payment from the Australian Government to those who have lost income.

Payments determined by assessment.

## Social, Economic and Environment Recovery Flexible Grants

Grants to support community recovery, events and resilience activities.

- Grants from \$2,500 up to \$50,000

## Small Business Interest Rate Subsidy\*

Interest rate subsidies for eligible small businesses on new loans to support recovery.

Energy bill relief available for eligible Exmouth residents and small businesses.
