The BRSC supports projects that address WA's bushfire research priorities, and subsequently improves accessibility, uptake and visibility of research and associated findings.

The BRSC operates under the governance of the [Interagency Bushfire Operations Committee](#) and includes representatives from Department Fire and Emergency Services (DFES), Department Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) and Western Australian Local Government Association (WALGA).
