A virginal math genius takes a job as a hedge fund quant after being lured from academia by his bosses' bikini model girlfriend, only to find out being the BSD might not be all it's cracked up to be.

SYNOPSIS:

Tanner Gabriels is a genius. That's why he's at the International Collegiate Mathlympiad, getting headhunted by billionaire Adrian Hotchkiss. Adrian might be amazed that the 19 year old putting ham on his face to pick up girls ("I have a fatal disease, can I touch your boobs before I go?") is the competition's highest scorer, but it doesn't stop him from offering Tanner a job at his hedge fund, Hotchkiss Capital. But Tanner can't be lured by Adrian's Bugatti. Actually, he isn't interested in the job at all—at least not until he catches a glimpse of Adrian's girlfriend, bikini model Claudia Karlsson. And girls like that date guys like Adrian Hotchkiss.

Two years later Tanner is working overtime at Hotchkiss Capital, running errands and grinding for a promotion to senior associate. In between making sports betting models for Adrian's degenerate head trader Gareth and learning enough Mandarin to communicate with monosyllabic quant Hai Pu, it looks like all of his work is about to pay off, but Adrian has one more favor to ask. He needs Tanner to drive Claudia home from a party, which just so happens to be hosted by fabled bikini company Wet Surprise.

Armed with Adrian's VIP lanyard and the keys to his Bugatti, Tanner gets a taste of what it's like to be a billionaire. But as he discovers the pleasures of the Wet Surprise mansion, Claudia is nowhere to be found. He eventually locates her alone in a bouncy castle, crying over a GED requirement that means she's no longer eligible to be Wet Surprise's Girl of the Year.

Determined to do his job, Tanner bribes Claudia back to the car with the promise of ice cream, a decision he soon regrets. Claudia insists on driving, and she brakes for wildlife. When a raccoon crosses the road and sends her cone flying onto the pristine interior of Adrian's Bugatti, Tanner sees his chance at senior associate vanish in a single scoop of chocolate chunk.

Devastated, he takes the only option available: a temporary transfer to sister company Davenport Bank, where he'll need to prove himself to Adrian's professional rival Logan Fraser if he wants the job. Although he hasn't given up hope of landing a Wet Surprise girl, Tanner will need some help if he wants to hack it at Davenport, the polar opposite of laid back Hotchkiss Capital.

Fortunately, Claudia has some ideas of her own: she'll help get Tanner laid, if he helps her pass the GED. It's a deal, but Tanner soon finds himself getting closer to Claudia than he intended: not good, since Adrian is technically still his boss. Claudia is making progress studying for her GED, but Tanner is having trouble with his own goal, and the clock is ticking before Claudia's first exam.

When her nerves get the better of her, Claudia points out that she's the one putting in work while Tanner hasn't faced up to his own assignment—kissing a girl. After she threatens to leave without taking the test, Tanner pulls Claudia in for a panty dropper of a kiss. She's shell shocked, and distracted enough to pass with flying colors.

They go out to a club to celebrate, where Tanner finds plenty of opportunities to test his new skills with the girls of Wet Surprise. The only one who doesn't show is Adrian, and Claudia has had enough. She breaks things off, and Tanner sacrifices his shot at bikini stunner Fliss Fowler to escort her home. At her place, Claudia and Tanner admit their feelings for each other—and Tanner shows her a new meaning of 'BSD.'

With his career at Davenport ready for takeoff and Adrian's ex-girlfriend now sharing his bed, Tanner decides to remain with Logan instead of returning to Hotchkiss Capital at the end of his term. He breaks the news to

Adrian on the golf course, and although Adrian is disappointed to see Tanner go, he's more disappointed that Tanner would think he based the promotion on what happened to the Bugatti rather than his readiness for the job.

Tanner's career at Hotchkiss Capital is officially over, but his star is still rising. In between wooing clients with Logan and his sexual exploits with Claudia, he's finally getting the hang of things—until Claudia shows up at the office and entices him into breaking Logan's only rule. Tanner is fired for having sex in the office, and after he implies she was dating Adrian for his money, Claudia also shows him the door.

Unemployed and alone, Tanner is wallowing on his couch when Gareth shows up. Gareth offers Tanner the promotion if he comes back to Hotchkiss Capital, working under him instead of Adrian. Tanner accepts, but there's no more glory in grunt work. As he prepares for another evening of overtime, Adrian suggests the two of them grab dinner—after all, he has a few questions about why a genius like Tanner would take the job in the first place.

"Girls," Tanner admits, and Adrian is incredulous. Did Tanner defer a PhD program at Harvard just to get girls to like him? He did, and to make things right, Adrian shows Tanner his own mugshot from the Mathlympiad—a picture so embarrassing it's been removed from the archives entirely. Adrian reminds Tanner that it's not always glamorous to be Adrian Hotchkiss, especially when you're constantly missing out. Besides, girls like Claudia care about more than just money, especially when they're making \$40M a year on their own. As they amicably part ways, Adrian gives Tanner two lanyards for the Girl of the Year party: and this time, they're in Tanner's name.

She accepts his apology, especially when she discovers he has left Hotchkiss Capital and will be starting his PhD in the fall. The two kiss and Claudia accepts her award for Girl of the Year, even though she has yet to pass biology, having learned to grow from her failures and stand up for her needs.

A year later, Tanner and Claudia's friends help them move into their new house near the Harvard campus, big enough for one PhD student and one part time bikini model. Claudia will be starting community college in the fall, and Tanner has learned that girls like Claudia Karlsson date guys who can be themselves.
