Summer Gardening Tips

Follow these summer gardening care tips below to keep plants thriving, and yourself enjoying all that the summertime has to offer.

5 Tips to Keep the Weeds Out of Your Gardens!

1. Plant close enough together to form a canopy. Close plant spacing prevents emerging weeds by shading the soil between plants.



2. Mulch vegetable garden paths and open areas with straw to prevent weeds from germinating.
3. Mulch gardens with a 2-3" thick layer of wood mulch like cedar or pine to help combat weeds in the gardens.



4. Watch for plants & trees that regularly reseed in your gardens and cut the seed heads off.

5. Stay on top of it!

Small weeds = small problem. Big weeds = big problem.

Hoe when it is dry, pull when it is wet!



5 Ways to Take Care of Your Hanging Baskets

1. Ensure your baskets receive the required amount of sun based on the plants needs.



2. Fertilize every week, or every 2 weeks, for bigger, better blooms with a water soluble Miracle Gro fertilizer, that is high in phosphorus- which promotes blooms.



3. Deadhead finished flowers to make way for new blooms.



4. Water often- usually every day in the heat of summer.



5. Trim long, “leggy” shoots to encourage new growth.
