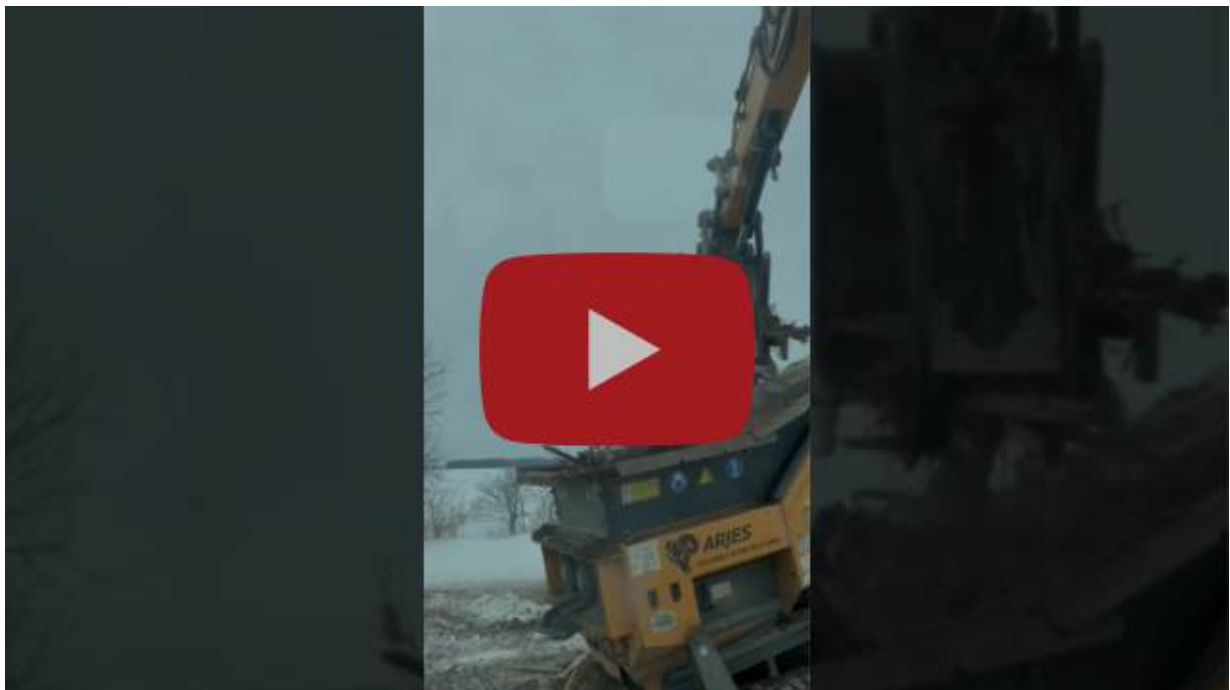


We just love these locally made birdhouses — each one unique in its own way.

We've added the ARJES IMPAKTOR 250 shredder to our fleet - a powerful step toward reducing landfill waste and giving construction & demolition materials a second life. Debris like wood, pallets, and brush are broken down for reusable compost. It also handles concrete and asphalt from our landscape projects, reducing demolition of debris so it can be recycled instead of sent to a landfill. We're turning waste into reusable resources and building a greener future from the ground up. ♻️
