

TRACXN GEO FUNDING TRENDS REPORT

UK FINTECH - 9M 2025



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Tracxn Insights (1/3)

- A total of \$3.1B was raised in 9M 2025, a drop of 16% compared to \$3.7B in 9M 2024 and in 9M 2023.
 - Seed Stage witnessed a total funding of \$146M in 9M 2025, a drop of 44% and 59% compared to \$260M in 9M 2024 and \$355M in 9M 2023, respectively.
 - Early Stage witnessed a total funding of \$1.1B in 9M 2025, a drop of 49% and 31% compared to \$2.1B in 9M 2024 and \$1.8B in 9M 2023, respectively.
 - Late Stage witnessed a total funding of \$1.9B in 9M 2025, a rise of 42% compared to \$1.3B in 9M 2024, and a rise of 21% compared to \$1.5B in 9M 2023.
- 9M 2025 has witnessed 8 100M+ funding rounds when compared to 5 such rounds in 9M 2024 and 6 in 9M 2023.
- Companies like Rapyd, FNZ, Dojo and Quantexa have managed to raise funds above \$100M in this period.

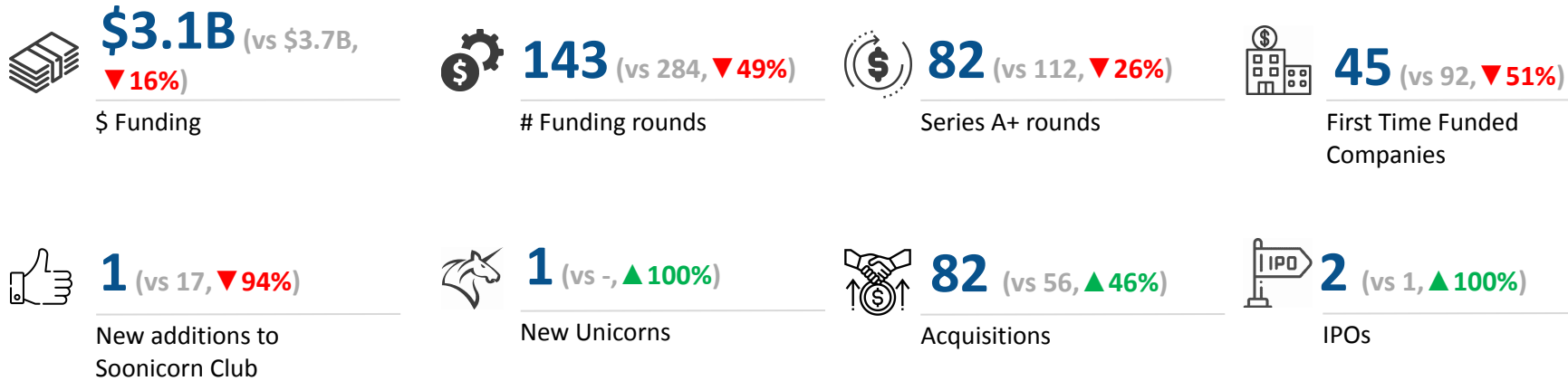
Tracxn Insights (2/3)

- Rapyd has raised a total of \$500M in a Series F round.
- FNZ has raised a total of \$500M in an Unattributed round.
- Dojo has raised a total of \$190M in a PE round.
- UK FinTech recorded 2 IPOs in 9M 2025, up by 100% compared to 1 in 9M 2024, and the same number as in 9M 2023.
 - RedCloud and Diginex are the companies that went public in 9M 2025.
- There was only one unicorn created in 9M 2025, a rise of 100% compared to no unicorn in 9M 2024 and the same number as in 9M 2023.
- FinTech companies in the United Kingdom saw 82 acquisitions in 9M 2025, a rise of 46% compared to 56 acquisitions in 9M 2024, and a rise of 49% compared to 55 acquisitions in 9M 2023.

Tracxn Insights (3/3)

- Worldpay was acquired by Global Payments at a price of \$24.3B.
 - This becomes the highest valued acquisition in 9M 2025 followed by the acquisition of OSTTRA by KKR at a price of \$3.1B.
- FinTech companies based in London received 90% of the total funding in United Kingdom, while Swindon came next with 5%.
- Y Combinator, Haatch and Project A were the top seed stage investors in UK FinTech ecosystem for 9M 2025.
- Notion, AlbionVC and DN Capital were the top early stage investors in UK FinTech ecosystem for 9M 2025.
- Latitude Venture Partners and Durable Capital Partners were the top late stage investors in UK FinTech ecosystem for 9M 2025.

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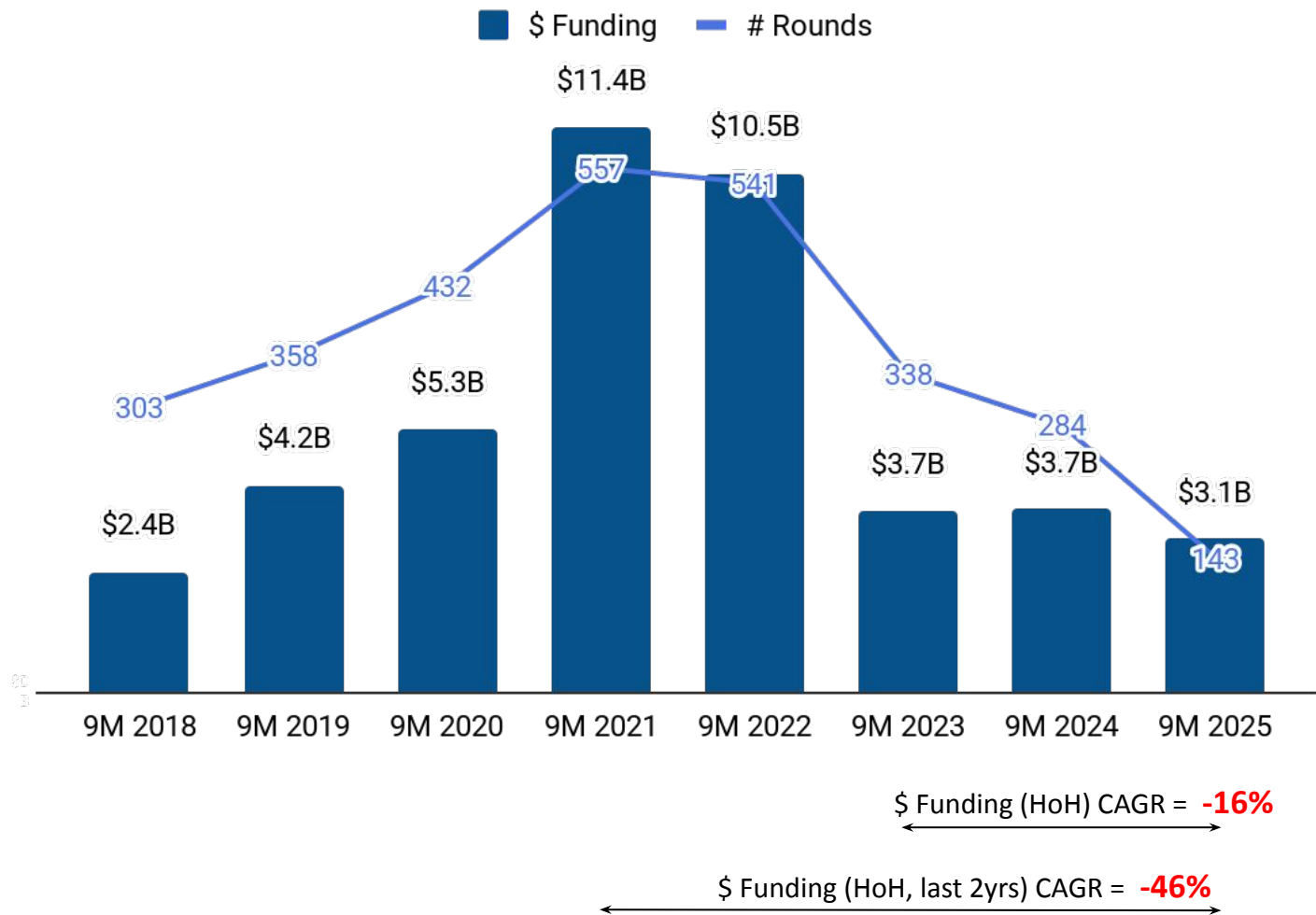

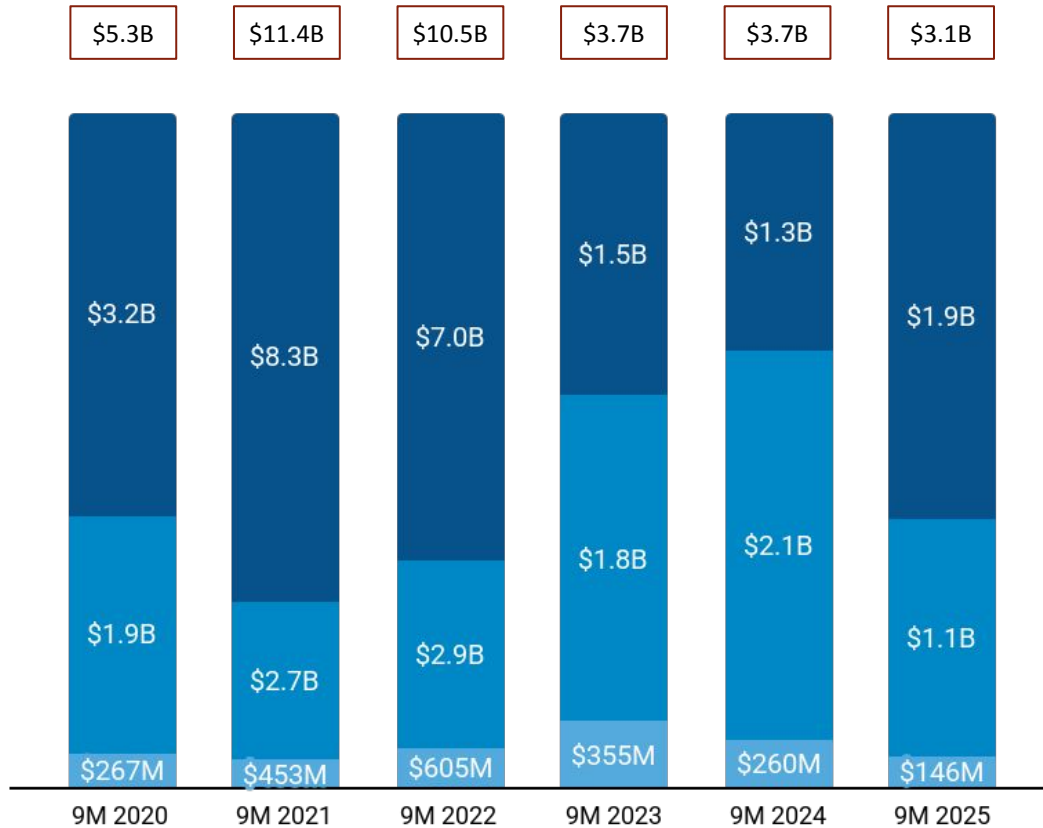

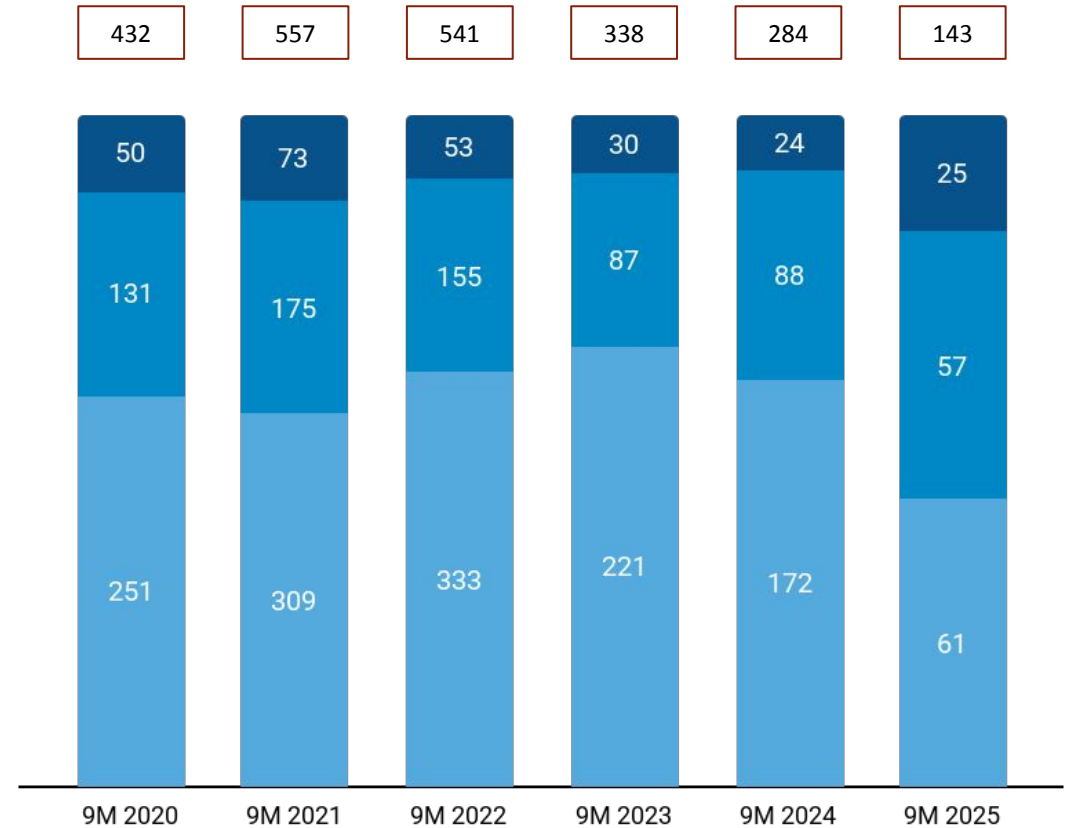

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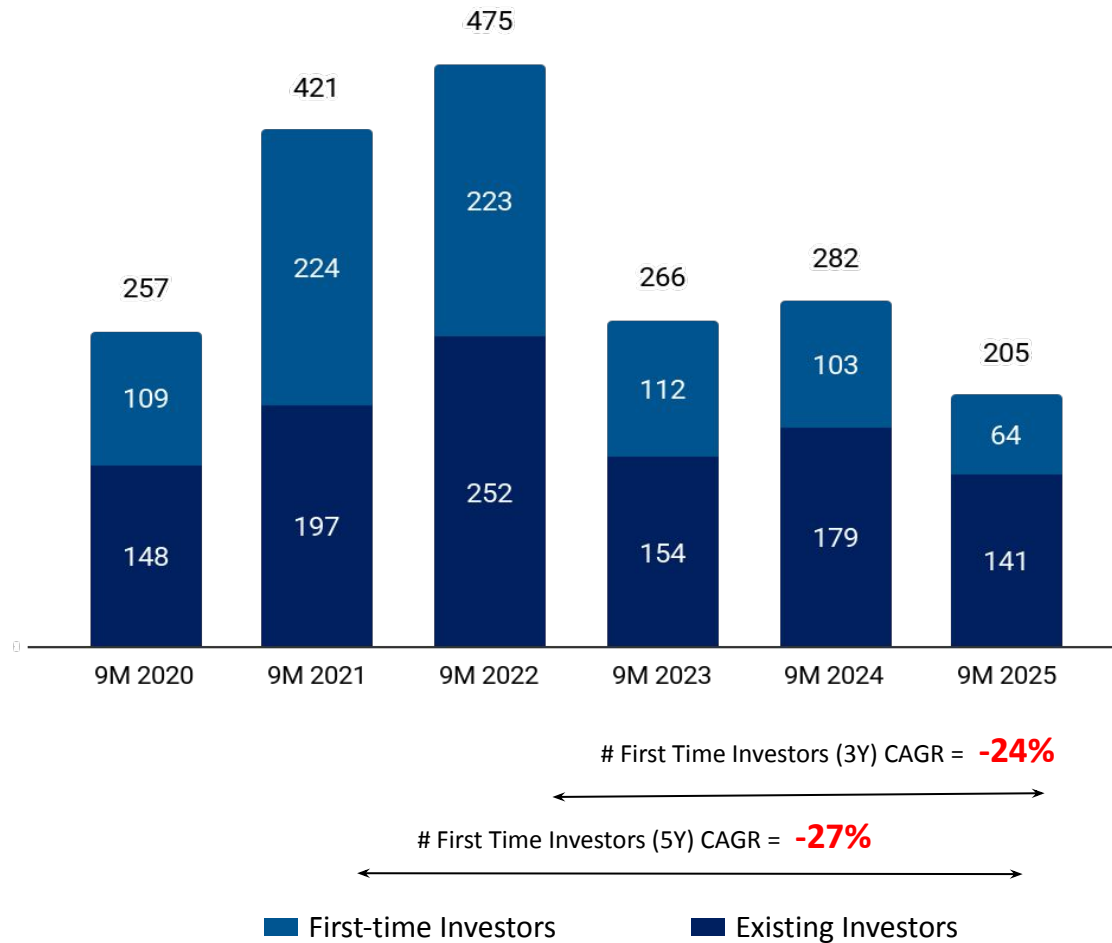

9M YTD # of unique Institutional Investors in UK FinTech



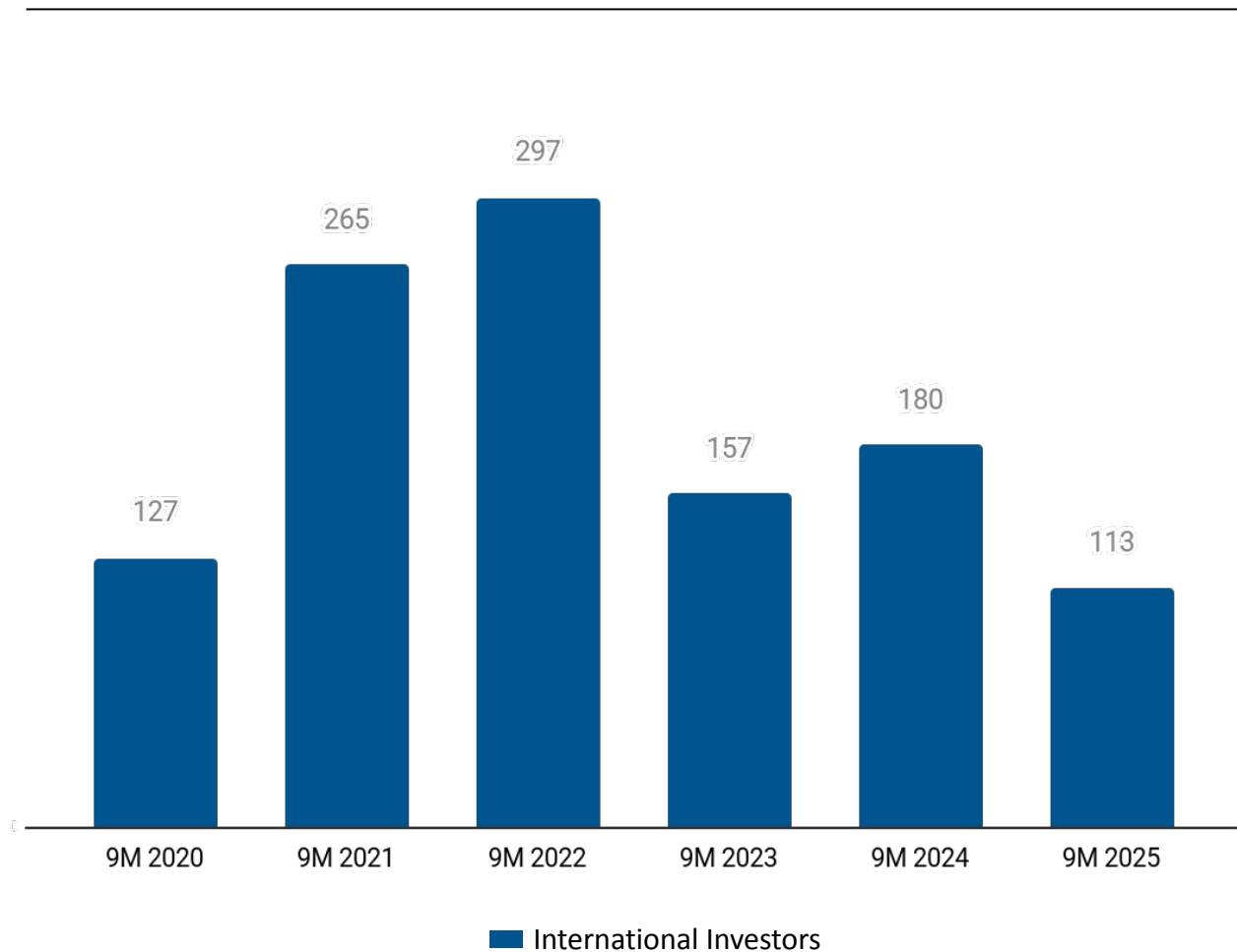

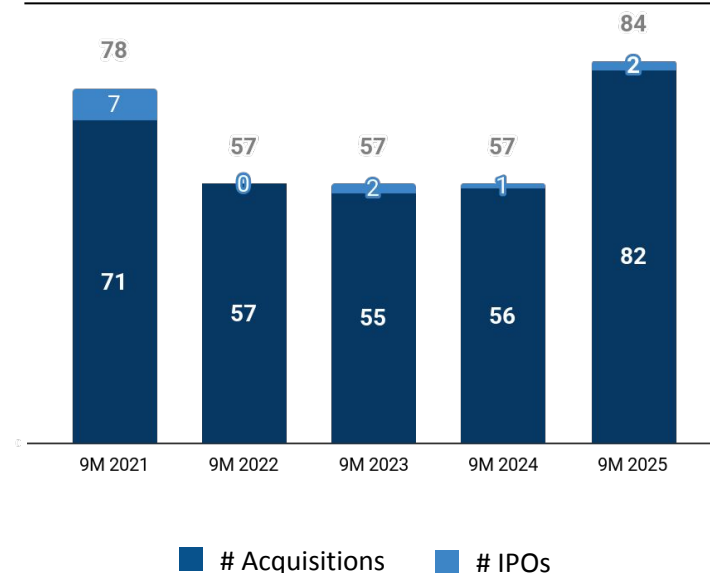

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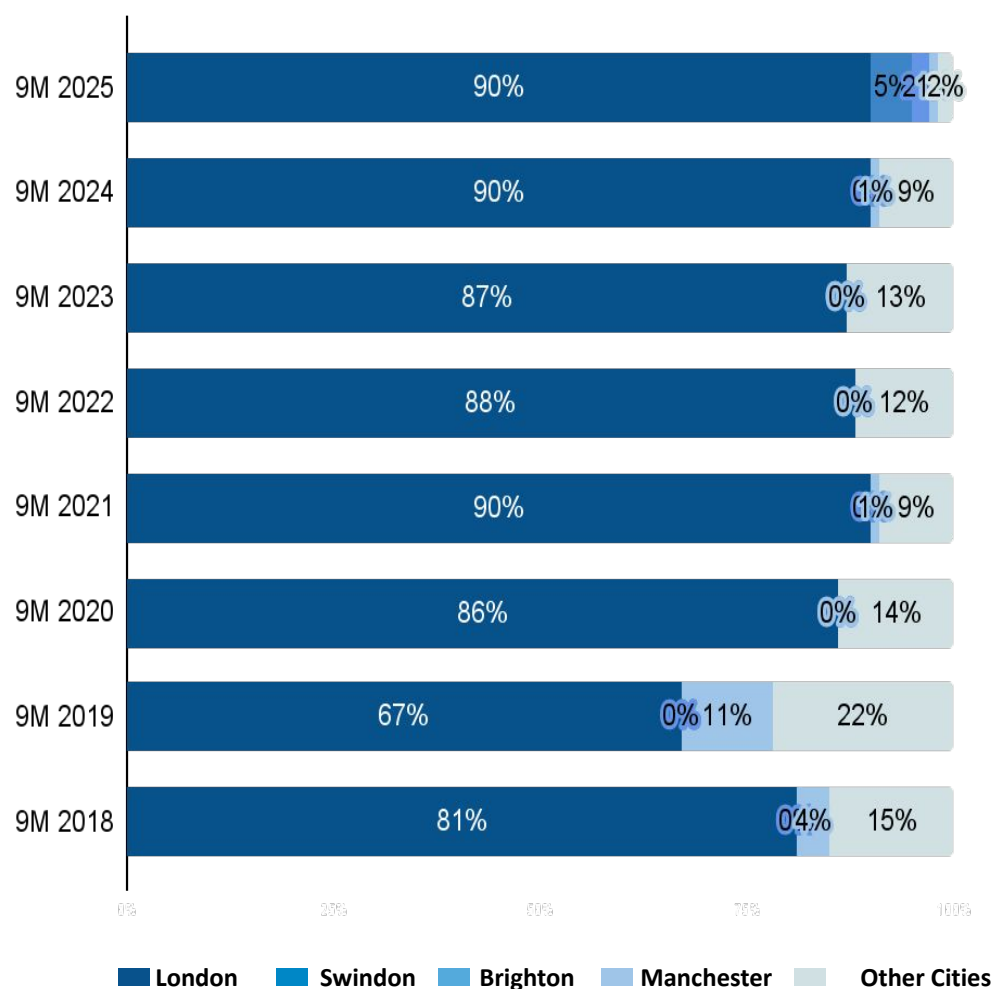
