Rules:

This competition will be conducted under the rules of the International Biathlon Union (IBU) Event and Competition Rules in effect at the time of competition except as modified by the AWGIC.

Eligibility to Participate:

All members of Biathlon Canada Divisions with a competitor membership card, correctly registered by their Divisions, are eligible to participate in the classes as authorized by the Biathlon Canada Hosting Policy. Athletes who are not members of a Division must purchase a day membership for each competition in which they wish to participate. **All athletes who are not regular members of Biathlon Yukon must participate in a mandatory safety and range procedure lesson (430-600 pm) held the Wednesday prior to the Trials.** Athletes must have been born in 2013 or earlier in order to meet the minimum age requirement of the AWG International Committee. More information on eligibility for selection to the 2026 Arctic Winter Games Team is included in the 2026 Arctic Winter Games Technical Package - Biathlon Snowshoe.

Fees:

There is no fee for Biathlon Yukon members. The fee for athletes from other Biathlon Canada Divisions or day members is \$20.
