I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to document the process by which required radiation signs are posted within Carolina Family Dental Center.

II. PROCEDURE

Required radiation signs are obtained from the North Carolina Radiation Safety Board. Signs will be laminated and posted in the appropriate areas, as designated below:

1. NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES

- This posting is located on the wall next to the back employee restroom and across from the break room.
- This posting contains information to employees regarding employer's responsibility, workers responsibility, subjects covered by this section, reports on radiation exposure history, inspections, and any other information that the agency may include

2. CAUTION RADIATION AREA WHEN X-RAY ENERGIZED

- This posting is located in each operatory. This posting is also located below the X-ray panel controlling the panoramic imaging unit. The symbol prescribed by this part shall use the colors magenta, or purple, or black on yellow background.

3. X-RAY EXPOSURE TECHNIQUES

- This posting is located in each operatory, adjacent to the CAUTION RADIATION AREA WHEN X-RAY ENERGIZED sign. The technique chart specifies a listing of information including anatomical size versus technique factors to be utilized at a given source to image receptor distance.
