### Casual Attire (“Dress Down Day”) Examples – Acceptable and Unacceptable

*Dress Down Day also includes all categories of business casual attire.*

<sup>1</sup>No political, sexually suggestive, inappropriate language or symbolism, or religious statements or ideology allowed on clothing in the workplace.

<sup>2</sup>Spaghetti straps, strapless tops, halter tops, and t-straps may only be worn when a jacket or sweater covers the exposed body areas.

<sup>3</sup>Skin-tight pants are not considered pants and are only acceptable when worn under a skirt or dress of appropriate length.

<sup>4</sup>Spaghetti strap or strapless dresses may be worn as long as a jacket or sweater covers the exposed body areas.
