Purpose of Position

Towne South Church of Christ is seeking a Worship Minister. We desire to find a musical worship leader who is passionate about people truly knowing Jesus and is in a committed relationship with Him. This person will be responsible for creating a Sunday morning experience that leads our congregation in worship of our God.

Qualifications

The Worship Minister should be a mature Christian who flees the evil desires of youth (2 Timothy 2:22), pursues righteousness (1 Timothy 6:11), and guards his life and doctrine closely (1 Timothy 4:16). In addition, the Worship Minister should have...

- A desire to serve Christ in Elizabeth City, NC.
- Excellent communication skills: verbal (confident and comfortable speaking in front of groups), written, and in relationships.
- A high degree of Bible literacy.
- Obvious leadership gifts or potential.
- A history of collaborating well with a team.
- A willingness to grow and become better at their role in the Kingdom.

All Towne South staff agree to our statement of beliefs and other life-style commitments that are communicated in our staff handbook.





Duties Directly Responsible

- Plan, organize, direct, and lead the band, vocals, and audio/visual/lighting (AVL) volunteers of Towne South and will lead the congregational musical worship for Sunday morning services and other needed events.
- Ensuring all worship experiences are executed in excellence.
- Develop, lead, and minister to the leaders and band members within Towne South's worship team(s) and AVL team(s) both musically and spiritually.
- Constantly re-evaluate current systems to see if there are better systems or methods that we could implement.
- Create and implement an infrastructure of all standard operating systems, volunteer leadership, and financial viability for the areas you oversee.
- Create a yearly budget with proposed items for improving the ministry.
- Keep up with sound, lighting, ProPresenter, and video hardware and software.
- Help create non-band elements (Click/Backing tracks, Drama, Scripture Reading, Stage Design, etc.) to further enhance and improve Sunday morning services, with respect to sermon and service themes.

Other Duties

- Attend staff meetings and staff retreats, contributing to the formation of vision and strategy of the entire church.
- Lead the church by example and cooperate with all other ministers in fulfilling church objectives.
- Attend all regularly scheduled church services and activities.
- Maintain a humble spirit and commitment to teamwork with other ministers, staff, and church members.
- Other tasks as assigned by the Lead Minister or Executive Minister.

Supervision Structure

The Worship Minister will work directly under the supervision of the Executive Minister.
