

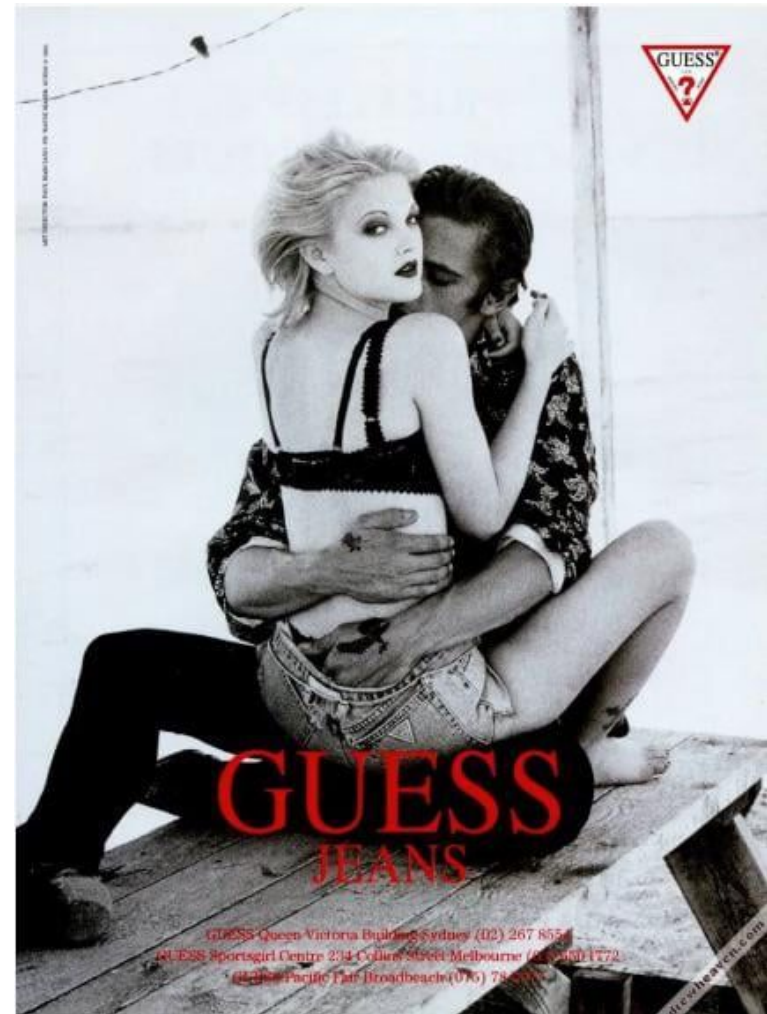


Guess

The company started in Los Angeles in 1981 as a book of styles by four brothers; Georges, Maurice, Armand, and Paul Marciano.

They then switched to selling jeans (**form fitting** denim with zippers at the ankle). But around 1980's, the company was accused for producing via sweatshop contractors in LA.

GUESS ad campaigns included supermodels, and was featured in movies like '*Back to the Future*' (1985)

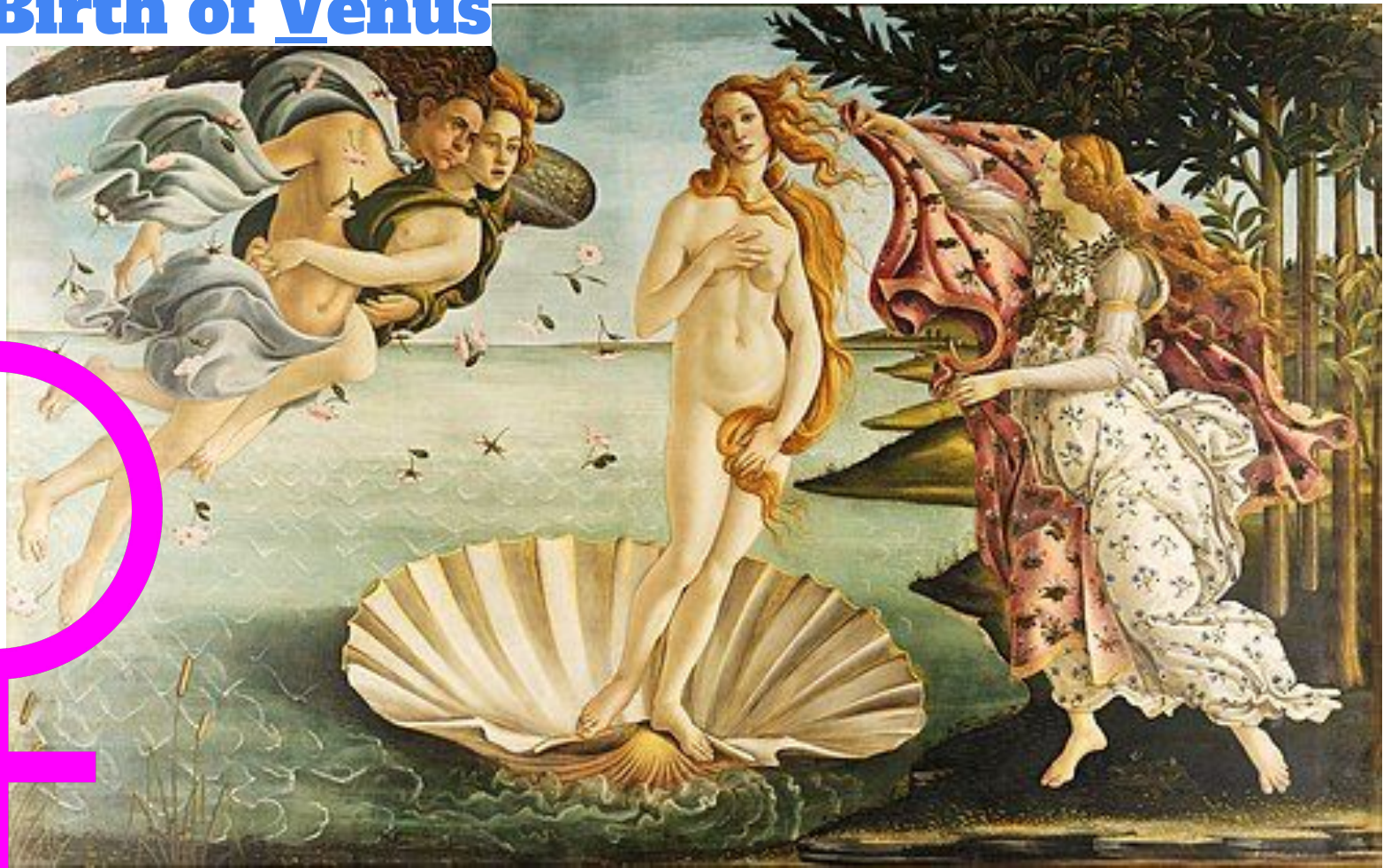

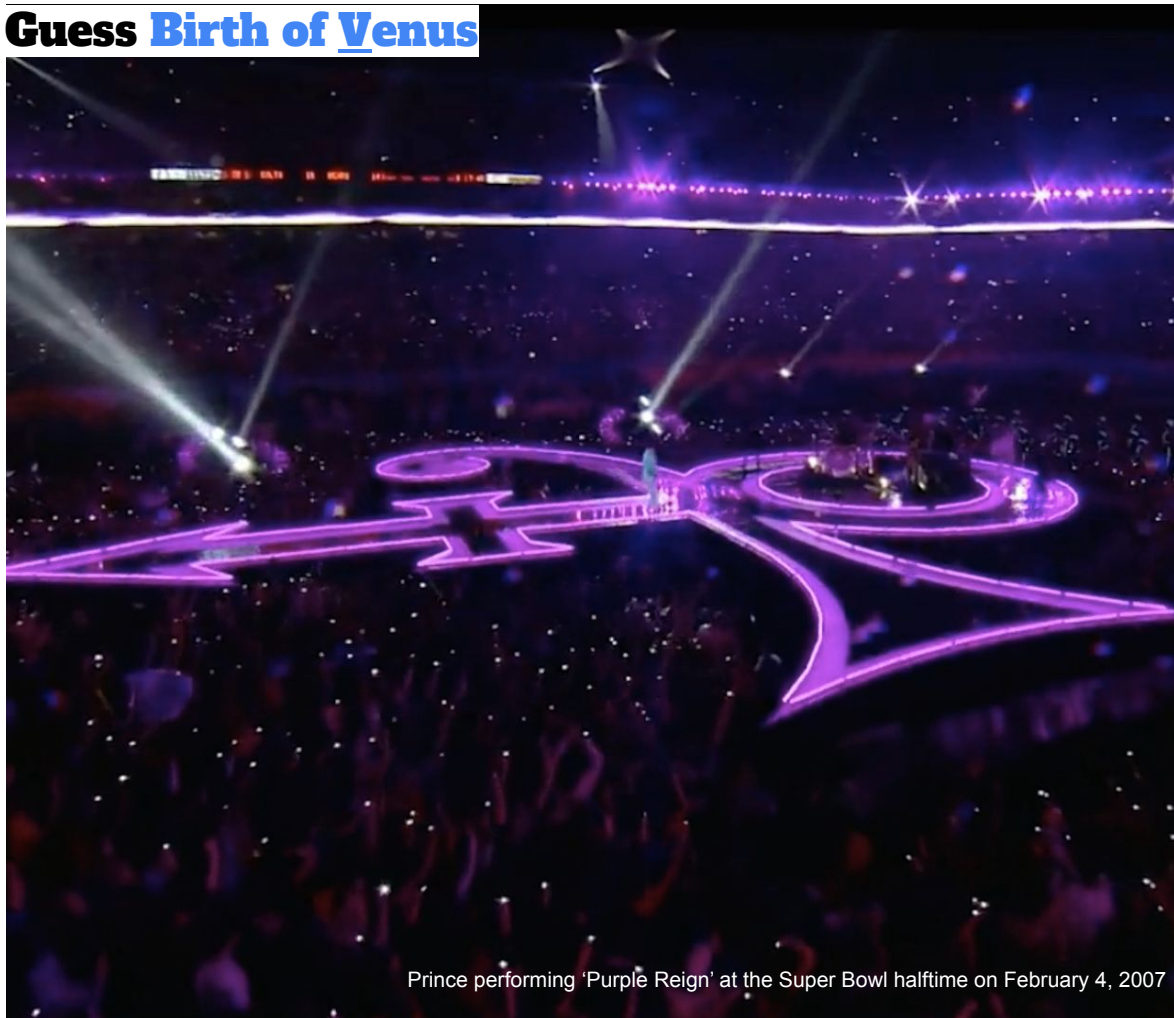

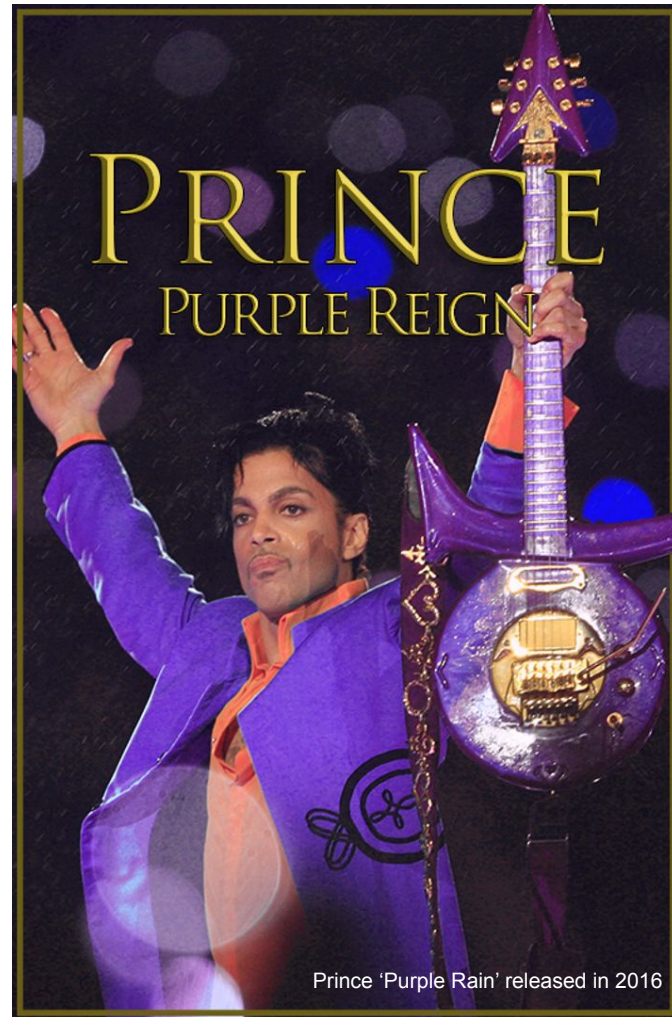
