Moving Checklist

- Contact moving companies. Get quotes, compare offers, and after choosing one, book your move date.
- Save by asking around for boxes and other packing necessities, then purchase the rest.
- Sell, donate and dispose of unwanted belongings.
- Locate and carefully pack important documents like medical and vet records.
- Book flights to your new home, if needed.






- If necessary, set up new utility accounts and cancel service with your existing providers effective after your move date.
- Check to see if you can set up or transfer your Ting Internet service to ensure you have internet access on day one in your new home.
- Start packing everyday belongings such as clothing, toys and tableware.
- Contact your local post office to set up mail forwarding.

day before



- Create your "moving day survival kit." Include a change of clothes, toiletries, clean towels and medications.
- Head to bed early in order to be well rested for the big day.



- Start packing non essentials including seasonal items, clothing and decor.
- Start clearing out storage areas like your garage, basement, attic and storage unit.
- Long drive to your new home? Have your car fully serviced!



week before

- Confirm your moving date and time with the moving company.
- Finish leftover food. The more you use, the less you'll have to transport or throw away.
- Pick out a week's worth of essentials like clothing and tableware to last until moving day; box the rest.
- Start cleaning. As you clear out rooms, vacuum and dust them as well.



Familiarize the movers with the area and items to be packed. Mention any concerns.
If you're doing a DIY move, pick up the moving truck as early as possible.
Do a final sweep of the house. Check closets and cabinets to ensure all belongings are removed.
Pick up the keys to your new home. Head to your new home and start moving in!
