Join IICF's Industrywide Initiatives, including the Fight to Alleviate Childhood Hunger

Since our founding in 1994, IICF has proudly served as the philanthropic voice and foundation of the insurance industry. Through industry generosity and support, IICF has responded to local community needs by awarding more than \$55 million in grants across the US and UK – and now in Canada. In addition, insurance professionals have contributed \$13+ million in volunteer service value in the communities where we live and work.

Established in response to the pandemic, [IICF Children's Hunger Relief](#) has grown since 2020 into an industrywide effort to alleviate childhood food insecurity. Through the generous support of the industry, we have helped to deliver millions of meals vulnerable children and their families.

The IICF Children's Hunger Relief campaign provides an opportunity for the industry to work in unison – and for individuals to [donate directly to help children in need](#) – as we raise funds that together will make a greater collective impact in the fight against childhood hunger.

IICF International Step Up Challenge

IICF's [International Step Up Challenge](#) also benefits IICF Children's Hunger Relief and childhood literacy. This unique, 4-week exercise challenge is designed to promote wellness and teambuilding while giving back – and winning teams and individuals can direct an IICF grant to the charity of their choice.

More than \$450,000 has been awarded in IICF Step Up grants, benefiting nonprofit partners serving children, through the generous participation of 17,000 insurance professionals, family and friends in 22 countries.
