- 1. *wren-boys* (Note from F.W. Horncastle's *Music of Ireland*, 1844): "On the anniversary of St. Stephen's Day groups of young villagers carry about a holly bush adorned with ribbons and with several wrens depending from it. This is conveyed from house to house with much ceremony, the wren-boys chanting several verses... Contributions are, of course, levied and the evening spent in merriment."
- 2. Saint Stephen's Day, December 26, celebrating the first Christian martyr
- 3. furze, a spiny evergreen shrub, common throughout Europe
