Curriculum Progression in World Faiths.

The study of world faiths is an inherent part of teaching and learning within the RE curriculum. Within school, the teaching of Christianity forms at least 50% of the teaching content of the curriculum. The other sections of the curriculum respond to the need for pupils to become 'RE Literate' and to hold 'balanced world views'. Therefore, we have developed a 'progression document' for the teaching content of the 'world faiths' section within the Curriculum. At school we make use of Diocesan units to inform curriculum planning for world faiths.
