Harvest Festival in Christ Church on Sunday


This Sunday, Christ Church is celebrating Harvest

provided in partnership with Yum Food Pantry


7:30pm – First confirmation preparation class – so if

We will be doing lots of activities and talking about how we can be kind to others and ourselves




