


Herd Farm residential information event for Y4-Y5 parents

Our Principles for Communication:

1

Respectful Dialogue

We ask that all conversations – written or spoken – are considerate and respectful. Whether sharing feedback, asking questions, or raising concerns, we aim to respond with support and compassion. We are committed to maintaining a safe and welcoming environment for all and will end any interaction that becomes abusive or threatening.

Timely Acknowledgement

We strive to acknowledge all communications within 48 hours (during term time). This means we will confirm we have received your message, let you know who is handling it, and, if possible, outline the next steps. For effective support, we encourage direct communication rather than using social media channels.

Appropriate Staff Response

Your enquiry will be directed to the most suitable available member of staff. This may not always be the person you initially contacted, but we will ensure your message reaches the right person.

Meetings by Appointment

To ensure staff can give you their full attention, meetings must be scheduled in advance. Staff are not available for unscheduled meetings during the academy day.

5

Decisions in the Best Interests of Students

Some decisions are made for the benefit of all students and may not require detailed discussion. These are in line with what all schools are allowed to do by law.

Complaints Process

We welcome feedback and are committed to addressing any concerns through our Trust Complaints Policy, available on our website. Once a complaint has been fully addressed through this process, we consider the matter closed and ask for your understanding.


7:30am - Breakfast Club (application only)
