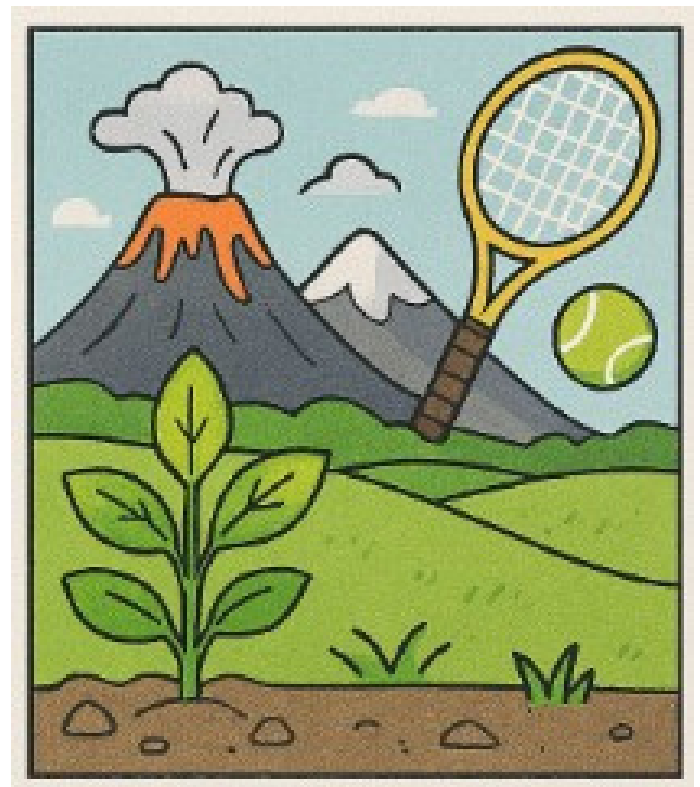
## Inclusion News

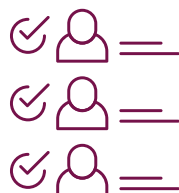
**7:30am** - Breakfast Club (application only)
