
# Great British Summer Savings Scheme

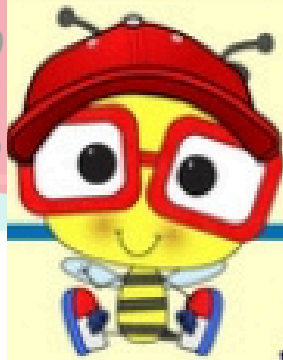

That's why we are delighted to share the details of our Great British Summer Savings scheme which will help local families going into the summer holidays know those little joys with the kids are going to be more affordable.

The Government is taking action to slash VAT from 20% down to 5% on children's menu meals, children's tickets for cinemas, theatres and concerts from 25th June to 1st September. Adults and children will also be able to enjoy amusement parks, wildlife parks, museums, soft play centres and a wide range of other attractions for less. On top of this, kids from 5 to 15 years old will get free bus travel in England this August, making it cheaper for people to get out and about.

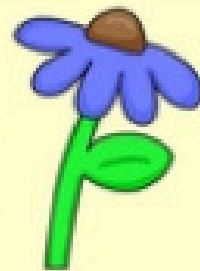

### Our School Day

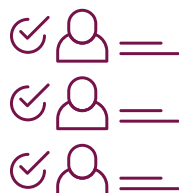
**7:30am** - Breakfast Club (application only)
