- We ask that you fill out the city event/ facility use permit paperwork, licensing and insurance, attached, and pay the necessary fees that the city requires.

We decided not to charge food vendors a booth fee this year, because we are benefitting from having you present, that our participants may enjoy refreshments, and we may have more people attend knowing food will be available. If you are willing to have a tip jar that benefits the fundraiser, that is appreciated, but not required.

There are picnic tables on the grounds with 6-8 large tables under a pavilion, where people may take their food to eat, and if we have enough food trucks, we may plan for additional seating.

If your organization would like to have a booth instead of a truck and sell food to fundraise for your organization, that is also ok, following the same rules as above.

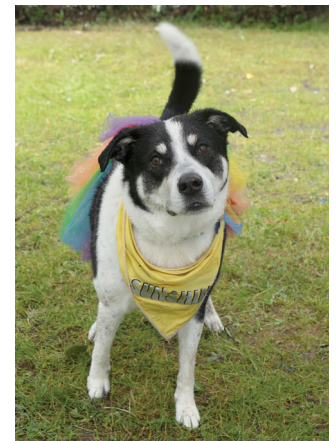
Due to the nature of the location, we cannot provide electricity.

# Short-Term Concessionaire Permit Application

Organizers of community and special events may contract with food, craft, and other concessionaires as part of the scheduled event. **An event representative shall provide the City with a list of the approved concessionaires in advance of the event.** All revenue-generating concessionaires/vendors associated with and designated by an approved community or special event must submit this completed application.

**ALL FEES AND DOCUMENTATION MUST BE RECEIVED A MINIMUM OF THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE EVENT.**

Each permit application must be accompanied by:

- **Permit fee** - \$41 per day when submitted 15 business days or more prior to the event. When submitted less than 15 business days in advance of the event, the permit fee is \$48 per day.
- **Certificate of Insurance** - food and drink vendors must submit insurance naming the additional insured as the **“City of Salem, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers.”**

**PERMITTEE MUST ALSO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING:**

- Concessionaires and vendors must obtain and display all required County Health Department licenses and/or permits throughout the event.
- Cooking on site is approved under the terms of this permit. All cooking units must meet state, county, and city health and safety standards. In addition, units are subject to inspection and approval by the City of Salem Fire Department and/or the State Fire Marshal.
- Concessionaires and vendors selling food and drink shall cover the ground under all food prep areas. Under the terms of this permit, you may be charged for litter pickup, litter disposal, damage to turf, and other damage incurred as a result of your concession.
- Under the authority of Salem Revised Code Chapter 94, the Community Services Department may issue special alcohol permits to sell alcoholic beverages and accompanies an additional fee of \$68. Alcohol may only be sold by licensed servers. Alcohol providers shall provide the City with copies of completed and approved Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) permit and approved insurance coverage. Permission to sell alcoholic beverages on City property is subject to any and all City of Salem and OLCC rules and regulations.
