Summer Retreat with Teresa Harrison

The Spiritual Practice of Icon Writing

June 1-5, 2026 | St. Paul's

Immerse yourself in the ancient spiritual practice of icon writing while in the comfort and beauty of our St. Paul's campus. Over the course of a week, create a Byzantine style icon in a meditative environment guided by gifted iconographer Teresa Harrison. The emphasis is on the step-by-step process of painting an icon, using Jo Sonia acrylic paint and 23 carat gold leaf, as well as on the spiritual practice of allowing God to work in us and through us. Each day begins with Holy Eucharist and includes intentional silence, listening to Gregorian chant, noonday prayer, group reflection, and teachings on the history of icons and the practice of praying with icons. This time set apart is joyful, transformative, and challenging. Open to all, regardless of art experience.

EASTER Offering

As we approach the Easter Day services, St. Paul's would like to continue the tradition of asking the parish to consider providing a heartfelt

gift to programs served through the Outreach Ministry. This year, gifts will go directly to the St. Paul's Crisis Fund. This longstanding financial support fund helps people in the community who are experiencing financial crisis due to loss of income, health-related crisis, or family crisis.

Did you know that the St. Paul's crisis fund does not necessarily pay for an entire bill or rent amount? Collaboration with like-minded community organizations to collectively pool funds to help people is a way of widening the impact. Strong relationships with leaders of downtown churches and community programs allow us to help those who need assistance and to connect them with several organizations, each provides a portion of the financial need. Recently, a single mother of 3 went through the loss of a job and had to turn to community organizations for help. Her Duke Energy, water and Piedmont Natural Gas bills were behind and growing steadily. By connecting with several churches and the Salvation Army, St. Paul's was able to bring together everyone to help the mother pay off all her bills and keep some of her savings for future food and rent. It was just the relief that she needed and has since been able to get back on track.
